AN ACT to amend the education law, the retirement and social security law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to permitting members of the New York state and New York city teachers' retirement systems to claim retirement credit for certain federal teaching service

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 509 of the education law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph d to read as follows:
- 3 D. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A MEMBER SHALL BE ENTI-TLED TO OBTAIN CREDIT FOR UP TO TEN YEARS OF SERVICE OTHER THAN MILITARY 5 SERVICE RENDERED IN THE EMPLOY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING SERVICE IN THE PEACE CORPS, VISTA, OR HEAD START, WHICH WOULD CONSTITUTE 7 SERVICE AS A TEACHER, HAD IT BEEN PERFORMED WITHIN NEW YORK STATE FOR AN EMPLOYER SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE. THECREDITING OF SERVICE PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULES AND 9 SHALL BE ADOPTED BY THE RETIREMENT BOARD, PROVIDED THAT 10 AS 11 SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL BE SUBSTANTIALLY EOUIVALENT TO 12 RULES AND REGULATIONS OTHERWISE APPLICABLE FOR THE CREDITING OF SERVICE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, NO SUCH CREDIT 13 SHALL 14 ALLOWED FOR ANY SERVICE FOR WHICH THE PERSON IS RECEIVING A BENEFIT OR WILL BE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE A BENEFIT AT ANY FUTURE TIME FROM SOME OTHER 15 PUBLIC OR PRIVATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR PLAN IN THIS STATE, IN ANY 16 STATE OR FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT. 17
 - S 2. Section 446 of the retirement and social security law is amended by adding a new subdivision k to read as follows:
- 20 K. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A MEMBER OF A TEACHERS' 21 RETIREMENT SYSTEM SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE

ENTITLED TO OBTAIN CREDIT FOR UP TO TEN YEARS OF SERVICE OTHER THAN MILITARY SERVICE RENDERED IN THE EMPLOY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING SERVICE IN THE PEACE CORPS, VISTA, OR HEAD START, WHICH WOULD SERVICE AS A TEACHER, HAD IT BEEN PERFORMED WITHIN NEW YORK STATE FOR AN EMPLOYER SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE. CREDITING OF SERVICE PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE 7 WITH RULES AND REGULATIONS AS SHALL BE ADOPTED BY THE RETIREMENT BOARD OF SUCH RETIREMENT SYSTEM, PROVIDED THAT SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS 9 SHALL BE SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OTHERWISE 10 APPLICABLE FOR THE CREDITING OF SERVICE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. 11 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, NO SUCH CREDIT SHALL BE ALLOWED FOR ANY SERVICE FOR WHICH THE PERSON IS RECEIVING A BENEFIT OR WILL BE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE A 12 BENEFIT AT ANY FUTURE TIME FROM SOME OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE RETIREMENT 13 14 SYSTEM OR PLAN IN THIS STATE, IN ANY OTHER STATE OR FROM THE FEDERAL 15 GOVERNMENT.

- S 3. Section 513 of the retirement and social security law is amended by adding a new subdivision i to read as follows:
- I. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A MEMBER OF A TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO OBTAIN CREDIT FOR UP TO TEN YEARS OF SERVICE OTHER THAN MILITARY SERVICE RENDERED IN THE EMPLOY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING SERVICE IN THE PEACE CORPS, VISTA, OR HEAD START, WHICH WOULD CONSTITUTE SERVICE AS A TEACHER, HAD IT BEEN PERFORMED WITHIN NEW YORK STATE FOR AN EMPLOYER SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, PROVIDED SUCH MEMBER MAKES THE PAYMENTS REQUIRED PURSUANT TO THE OF SECTION FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTEEN OF THIS ARTICLE. THE CRED-PROVISIONS ITING OF SERVICE PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULES AND REGULATIONS AS SHALL BE ADOPTED BY THE RETIREMENT BOARD OF SUCH RETIREMENT SYSTEM, PROVIDED THAT SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL BE SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OTHERWISE APPLICABLE FOR THE CREDITING OF SERVICE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, NO SUCH CREDIT SHALL BE ALLOWED FOR ANY SERVICE FOR WHICH THE PERSON IS RECEIVING A BENEFIT OR WILL BE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE A BENEFIT AT ANY FUTURE TIME FROM SOME OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR PLAN IN THIS STATE, IN ANY OTHER STATE OR FROM THE GOVERNMENT.
- S 4. Section 609 of the retirement and social security law is amended by adding a new subdivision h to read as follows:
- 39 H. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A MEMBER OF A TEACHERS' 40 RETIREMENT SYSTEM SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO OBTAIN CREDIT FOR UP TO TEN YEARS OF SERVICE OTHER THAN 41 MILITARY SERVICE RENDERED IN THE EMPLOY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, 42 INCLUDING SERVICE IN THE PEACE CORPS, VISTA, OR HEAD START, WHICH WOULD 43 44 CONSTITUTE SERVICE AS A TEACHER, HAD IT BEEN PERFORMED WITHIN NEW STATE FOR AN EMPLOYER SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, 45 THE PAYMENTS REQUIRED PURSUANT PROVIDED SUCH MEMBER MAKES TO THE 47 PROVISIONS OF SECTION SIX HUNDRED THIRTEEN OF THIS ARTICLE AND PARAGRAPH TWO OF SUBDIVISION B OF THIS SECTION. THE CREDITING OF SERVICE PURSUANT 48 49 TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULES AND REGULATIONS AS 50 SHALL BE ADOPTED BY THE RETIREMENT BOARD OF SUCH RETIREMENT SYSTEM, PROVIDED THAT SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL BE SUBSTANTIALLY EOUIV-51 ALENT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OTHERWISE APPLICABLE FOR THE CREDIT-52 ING OF SERVICE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, NO SUCH 53 54 CREDIT SHALL BE ALLOWED FOR ANY SERVICE FOR WHICH THE PERSON IS RECEIV-55 A BENEFIT OR WILL BE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE A BENEFIT AT ANY FUTURE

- S 5. Subparagraph (d) of paragraph 3 of subdivision a of section 13-505 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended to read as follows:
- (d) Credit for such prior service up to a maximum of fifteen years shall be given only if application and payment therefor is made by the contributor within the first four years subsequent to membership in the New York city teachers' retirement system or before December thirty-first, [nineteen hundred sixty-nine] TWO THOUSAND TWELVE, whichever is later.
- S 6. Subdivision a of section 13-505 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new paragraph 10 to read as follows:
- 15 10. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A MEMBER SHALL BE ENTITLED TO OBTAIN CREDIT FOR UP TO TEN YEARS OF SERVICE OTHER THAN MILITARY SERVICE RENDERED IN THE EMPLOY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, 16 17 INCLUDING SERVICE IN THE PEACE CORPS, VISTA, OR HEAD START, WHICH WOULD 18 19 CONSTITUTE SERVICE AS A TEACHER, HAD IT BEEN PERFORMED WITHIN NEW YORK STATE FOR AN EMPLOYER SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF 20 THIS CHAPTER. 21 CREDITING OF SERVICE PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE 22 WITH RULES AND REGULATIONS AS SHALL BE ADOPTED BY THE RETIREMENT BOARD, 23 PROVIDED THAT SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL BE SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIV-24 ALENT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OTHERWISE APPLICABLE FOR THE CREDIT-25 ING OF SERVICE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, NO SUCH CREDIT SHALL BE ALLOWED FOR ANY SERVICE FOR WHICH THE PERSON IS RECEIV-26 27 ING A BENEFIT OR WILL BE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE A BENEFIT AT ANY FUTURE TIME FROM SOME OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR PLAN IN THIS 28 STATE, IN ANY OTHER STATE OR FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT. 29
- 30 S 7. This act shall take effect June 30, 2012.
