AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to persons authorized to practice social work

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivisions 2 and 4 of section 7707 of the education law, 2 subdivision 2 as amended by chapter 230 of the laws of 2004 and subdivi-3 sion 4 as added by chapter 420 of the laws of 2002, are amended to read 4 as follows:

5 2. Any person who possesses a master's of social work degree on [the 6 effective date of this section] SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOUR, who has five years of post-graduate social work employment BY SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOUR and meets the requirements for a license pursu-7 8 9 to this article, except for examination, and who files with the ant department [within one year of the effective date of this section] BY 10 DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TWELVE shall be 11 licensed as a 12 licensed master social worker.

13 4. Any person who is licensed as a certified social worker on [the 14 effective date of this section] SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOUR, but 15 who has not received authorization pursuant to section three thousand 16 two hundred twenty-one or four thousand three hundred three of the insurance law, who files with the department [within one year of the effective date of this section] BY DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND 17 18 19 TWELVE an application pursuant to subdivision two of section seventy-20 seven hundred four of this article, AND who demonstrates BY SEPTEMBER FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOUR to the satisfaction of the department that they 21 meet the experience requirements for authorization pursuant to section 22 23 three thousand two hundred twenty-one or four thousand three hundred 24 three of the insurance law, shall be licensed as a licensed clinical 25 social worker without meeting any further requirements.

26 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
