AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to the penalties for operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 1193 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 75 of the laws of 1994, is amended to read as follows:

- (a) Driving while ability impaired. A violation of subdivision one of section eleven hundred ninety-two of this article shall be a traffic infraction and shall be punishable by a fine of not less than three hundred dollars nor more than five hundred dollars or by imprisonment in a penitentiary or county jail for not more than fifteen days, or by both 9 such fine and imprisonment. A person who operates a vehicle in violation such subdivision after having been convicted of a violation of any 10 subdivision of section eleven hundred ninety-two of this article within the preceding five years shall be GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR, AND SHALL BE punished by a fine of not less than [five] SEVEN hundred FIFTY dollars more than [seven hundred fifty] ONE THOUSAND dollars, or by impri-14 sonment of not more than [thirty] NINETY days in a penitentiary or county jail or by both such fine and imprisonment. A person who operates a vehicle in violation of such subdivision after having been convicted two more times of a violation of any subdivision of section eleven hundred ninety-two of this article within the preceding ten years shall guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a fine of not less than [seven hundred fifty] ONE THOUSAND dollars nor more than [fifteen hundred] TWO THOUSAND dollars, or by imprisonment of not more than one 23 hundred eighty days in a penitentiary or county jail or by both 24 fine and imprisonment.
- S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-25 ing the date on which it shall have become a law. 26
