- AN ACT in relation to broadcasting of professional sporting events of publicly funded stadiums

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Broadcasting of home games in publicly funded stadiums. 1 a. the broadcast of any home sporting event of a professional sports 2 If team or franchise whose home stadium is located in this state is blacked 3 out for any reason, including under the blackout rules of the profes-4 5 sional league to which such team or franchise is a member, the professional sports team or franchise shall be ineligible to receive any public funds from the state of New York in the next state fiscal year. 6 7 8 b. The provisions of this section shall not apply to:

9 (i) Any public funds already appropriated prior to the effective date 10 of this section.

(ii) Any revenues from taxes to support a sports franchise, stadium, or sports complex if such tax levy is in effect on the effective date of this section; and

14 (iii) Any public funds appropriated or allocated which would consti-15 tute a breach of contract if such funds were not distributed in accord-16 ance with such contract.

17 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
