AN ACT to amend the New York city civil court act, in relation to the election of additional judges of the civil court of the city of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 102-a of the New York city civil court act, as added by chapter 511 of the laws of 1993, is amended to read as follows:

The twenty-five additional judges of the civil court of the city of New York authorized on June first, nineteen hundred sixty-eight by chapter nine hundred eighty-seven of the laws of nineteen hundred sixty-7 eight shall be elected in and from the residents of the following counties in the indicated numbers: from the county of New York, seven; from 9 the county of Kings, seven; from the county of Queens, six; from the county of Bronx, four; and from the county of Richmond, one. Such addi-10 tional judges shall receive the same compensation as the existing judges 11 of the civil court of the city of New York. The eleven additional judges 12 of the civil court of the city of New York authorized by [this] 13 SEVEN OF CHAPTER FIVE HUNDRED OF THE LAWS OF NINETEEN HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO 14 [chosen by the electors of the counties included within the 15 shall be 16 city of New York from districts within such counties as shall be 17 lished by law] ELECTED IN AND FROM THE RESIDENTS OF THE FOLLOWING COUN-18 TIES IN THE INDICATED NUMBERS: FROM THE COUNTY OF NEW YORK, ONE; COUNTY OF KINGS, THREE; FROM THE COUNTY OF OUEENS, FOUR; FROM THE 19 COUNTY OF BRONX, TWO; AND FROM THE COUNTY OF RICHMOND, ONE. 20 SUCH ADDI-TIONAL JUDGES SHALL RECEIVE THE SAME COMPENSATION AS THE EXISTING JUDGES 21 22 OF THE CIVIL COURT OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK.
