Introduced by Sen. GOLDEN -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Transportation

AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to leaving the scene of an incident causing personal injury to another person without reporting

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 600 of the vehicle  
2 and traffic law, as amended by chapter 49 of the laws of 2005, is  
3 amended to read as follows:  
4 a. Any person operating a motor vehicle who, [knowing or having cause  
5 to know that personal injury has been caused to another person,] due to  
6 an incident involving the motor vehicle operated by such person, CAUSED  
7 PERSONAL INJURY TO ANOTHER PERSON shall, before leaving the place where  
8 the said personal injury occurred, stop, exhibit his or her license and  
9 insurance identification card for such vehicle, when such card is  
10 required pursuant to articles six and eight of this chapter, and give  
11 his or her name, residence, including street and street number, insur-  
12 ance carrier and insurance identification information including but not  
13 limited to the number and effective dates of said individual's insurance  
14 policy and license number, to the injured party, if practical, and also  
15 to a police officer, or in the event that no police officer is in the  
16 vicinity of the place of said injury, then, he or she shall report said  
17 incident as soon as physically able to the nearest police station or  
18 judicial officer.  
19 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-  
20 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
