AN ACT to amend the general city law, in relation to providing for the granting of a deduction in personal income tax imposed by a city for home security expenses

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The third undesignated paragraph of section 25-a of the
2 general city law is amended by adding a new subparagraph (d) to read as
3 follows:
4 (D) ANY SUCH LOCAL LAW MAY BE AMENDED TO PROVIDE THAT AN INDIVIDUAL
5 WHO IS OWNER OCCUPANT OF A ONE, TWO, THREE, FOUR OR FIVE FAMILY HOME
6 SHALL BE ENTITLED TO SUBTRACT FROM HIS OR HER FEDERAL ADJUSTED GROSS
7 INCOME THE EXPENSES OF PROVIDING SECURITY FOR HIS OR HER HOME INCLUDING
8 EXTERIOR LIGHTING, BURGLAR AND FIRE ALARMS AND SUCH OTHER SECURITY
9 EXPENSES AS SHALL BE ALLOWABLE PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUCH LOCAL
10 LAW.
11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding
12 the date on which it shall have become a law.
