- AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to authorizing a tax check-off for the state library system

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 630-c to 2 read as follows:

3 630-C. GIFTS FOR THE STATE LIBRARY SYSTEM. EFFECTIVE FOR ANY TAX S 4 YEAR COMMENCING ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TWELVE, AN INDI-5 VIDUAL IN ANY TAXABLE YEAR MAY ELECT TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE STATE LIBRARY 6 PROGRAM FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR PUBLIC LIBRARIES AND LIBRARY AID 7 SYSTEMS, REFERENCE AND RESEARCH LIBRARY RESOURCE SYSTEMS, THE NEW YORK PUBLIC RESEARCH LIBRARIES, THE SCHOMBURG COLLECTION AND THE LIBRARY FOR 8 THE BLIND AND VISUALLY HANDICAPPED. SUCH CONTRIBUTION SHALL BE 9 IN ANY WHOLE DOLLAR AMOUNT AND SHALL NOT REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF STATE TAX OWED BY 10 INDIVIDUAL. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL INCLUDE SPACE ON THE PERSONAL 11 SUCH INCOME TAX RETURN TO ENABLE A TAXPAYER TO MAKE 12 SUCH CONTRIBUTION. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW ALL REVENUES COLLECTED PURSU-13 TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE STATE LIBRARY AID PROGRAM 14 ANT AND SHALL BE USED IN ADDITION TO, NOT TO SUPPLANT, 15 EXISTING FUNDING 16 UNDER THE STATE LIBRARY AID PROGRAM AND USED FOR ONLY THOSE PURPOSES 17 ENUMERATED IN SECTION TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE OF THE EDUCATION LAW. 18 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
