AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring adequate training in the Heimlich maneuver and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) for new certification as a school teacher

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 3004 of the education law is amended by adding a  
2 new subdivision 7 to read as follows:  
3 7. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL  
4 PRESCRIBE REGULATIONS REQUIRING THAT ALL PERSONS APPLYING, ON OR AFTER  
5 JULY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN, FOR A CERTIFICATE OR LICENSE TO BE A  
6 TEACHER SHALL, IN ADDITION TO ALL THE OTHER CERTIFICATION OR LICENSURE  
7 REQUIREMENTS, HAVE COMPLETED ADEQUATE TRAINING IN THE HEIMLICH MANEUVER  
8 AND CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR). THE TRAINING SHALL BE OBTAINED  
9 FROM AN INSTITUTION OR PROVIDER WHICH HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE DEPART-  
10 MENT TO PROVIDE SUCH TRAINING. EACH APPLICANT SHALL PROVIDE THE DEPART-  
11 MENT WITH DOCUMENTATION SHOWING THAT HE OR SHE HAS COMPLETED THE  
12 REQUIRED TRAINING.  
13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
