BONACIC, AVELLA, FUSCHILLO -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Transportation -- reported favorably from said committee, ordered to first and second report, ordered to a third reading, amended and ordered reprinted, retaining its place in the order of third reading
- AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to approaching a parked, stopped or standing hazard vehicle on the shoulder of a highway

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic 2 law, as amended by chapter 387 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read 3 as follows:

4 3. Application for learner's permit. An application for a learner's 5 permit shall be included in the application for a license. A learner's permit shall be issued in such form as the commissioner shall determine б 7 but shall not be issued unless the applicant has successfully passed the 8 vision test required by this section and the test set forth in paragraph (a) of subdivision four of this section with respect to laws relating to 9 traffic and ability to read and comprehend traffic signs and symbols and 10 has satisfactorily completed any course required pursuant to paragraph 11 12 (a) of subdivision four of this section. Upon acceptance of an applica-13 tion for a learner's permit the commissioner shall provide the applicant with a driver's manual which includes but is not limited to the 14 laws 15 relating to traffic, the laws relating to and physiological effects of driving while ability impaired and driving while intoxicated, the law 16 exercising due care to avoid colliding with a parked, stopped or 17 for 18 standing authorized emergency vehicle OR HAZARD VEHICLE pursuant to section eleven hundred forty-four-a of this chapter, explanations of 19 20 traffic signs and symbols and such other matters as the commissioner may 21 prescribe.

1 S 2. Subparagraph (i) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 4 of section 502 2 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 387 of the laws of 3 2010, is amended to read as follows:

4 (i) Upon submission of an application for a driver's license, the 5 applicant shall be required to take and pass a test, or submit evidence 6 of passage of a test, with respect to the laws relating to traffic, the laws relating to driving while ability is impaired and while intoxicat-7 8 ed, under the overpowering influence of "Road Rage", or "Work Zone Safe-9 awareness as defined by the commissioner, the law relating to exerty" 10 cising due care to avoid colliding with a parked, stopped or standing authorized emergency vehicle OR HAZARD VEHICLE pursuant to section elev-11 en hundred forty-four-a of this chapter, the ability to read and compre-12 hend traffic signs and symbols and such other matters as the commission-13 14 may prescribe, and to satisfactorily complete a course prescribed by er 15 the commissioner of not less than four hours and not more than five hours, consisting of classroom driver training and highway safety 16 instruction or the equivalent thereof. Such test shall include at least 17 18 seven written questions concerning the effects of consumption of alcohol 19 drugs on the ability of a person to operate a motor vehicle and the or 20 legal and financial consequences resulting from violations of section 21 eleven hundred ninety-two of this chapter, prohibiting the operation of 22 a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Such test 23 shall include one or more written questions concerning the devastating 24 effects of "Road Rage" on the ability of a person to operate a motor 25 vehicle and the legal and financial consequences resulting from assault-26 ing, threatening or interfering with the lawful conduct of another 27 person legally using the roadway. Such test shall include one or more questions concerning the potential dangers to persons and equipment 28 29 resulting from the unsafe operation of a motor vehicle in a work zone. 30 Such test may include one or more questions concerning the law for exercising due care to avoid colliding with a parked, stopped or 31 standing 32 authorized emergency vehicle OR HAZARD VEHICLE pursuant to section elev-33 en hundred forty-four-a of this chapter. Such test shall be administered the commissioner. The commissioner shall cause the applicant to take 34 by 35 a vision test and a test for color blindness. Upon passage of the vision 36 test, the application may be accepted and the application fee shall be payable. 37

38 S 3. Section 1144-a of the vehicle and traffic law, as added by chap-39 ter 387 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows:

40 S 1144-a. Operation of vehicles when approaching a parked, stopped or standing authorized emergency vehicle OR HAZARD VEHICLE. Every operator 41 42 a motor vehicle shall exercise due care to avoid colliding with an of 43 authorized emergency vehicle OR HAZARD VEHICLE which is parked, stopped 44 standing on the shoulder or any portion of such highway and such or 45 authorized emergency vehicle is displaying one or more red or combination red, BLUE and white lights pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 46 47 two of subdivision forty-one of section three hundred seventy-five of chapter AND 48 this SUCH HAZARD VEHICLE IS DISPLAYING ONE OR MORE AMBER 49 LIGHTS PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH THREE OF SUBDIVISION 50 FORTY-ONE SECTION THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE OF THIS CHAPTER. OF For 51 operators of motor vehicles on parkways or controlled access highways, such due care shall include, but not be limited to, moving from a lane 52 53 which contains or is immediately adjacent to the shoulder where such 54 authorized emergency vehicle [displaying one or more red or combination 55 red and white lights pursuant to the provisions of paragraph two of subdivision forty-one of section three hundred seventy-five of this 56

1 chapter] OR HAZARD VEHICLE is parked, stopped or standing to another 2 lane, provided that such movement otherwise complies with the require-3 ments of this chapter including, but not limited to, the provisions of 4 sections eleven hundred ten of this title and eleven hundred twenty-5 eight of this title.

6 S 4. This act shall take effect September 1, 2011; provided that: (a) 7 any rules and regulations, and the taking of any other actions necessary 8 to implement the provisions of such sections of this act are authorized 9 and directed to be made on or before such effective date; and (b) 10 section three of this act shall take effect January 1, 2012.
