AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to providing incentives for energy conservation through voltage regulation

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The public service law is amended by adding a new section 2 66-m to read as follows:
 - S 66-M. VOLTAGE REGULATION. 1. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION "VOLTAGE REGULATION DEVICE" SHALL MEAN VOLTAGE REGULATION TECHNOLOGIES WHICH RAISE OR LOWER VOLTAGE DYNAMICALLY AND ARE NINETY-NINE PERCENT OR MORE EFFICIENT ACROSS AT LEAST NINETY PERCENT OF THE ELECTRIC LOAD CURVE.
- 7 2. ELECTRIC UTILITIES MAY RECOVER THE CAPITAL AND OPERATING COSTS AND 8 EARN A FIFTEEN PERCENT RATE OF RETURN IN THE UTILITY'S RATE BASES ON 9 INVESTMENTS AND INSTALLATIONS OF VOLTAGE REGULATION DEVICES.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
