AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, the state finance law and the public health law, in relation to implementing the "New York state organ donor awareness and education act"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "New York State Organ Donor Awareness and Education Act."

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- S 2. Paragraph b of subdivision 1 of section 401 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 222 of the laws of 1996, is amended to read as follows:
- Every owner of a motor vehicle which shall be operated or driven upon the public highways of this state shall, except as otherwise expressly provided, cause to be presented, by mail or otherwise, to the office or a branch office of the commissioner, or to any agent of the commissioner, constituted as provided in this chapter, an application for registration addressed to the commissioner, and on a blank to be prepared under the direction of and furnished by the commissioner for that purpose, containing: (a) a brief description of the motor vehicle to be registered, including the name and factory number of such vehicle, such other facts as the commissioner shall require; (b) the weight of the vehicle upon which the registration fee is based if the based on weight; (c) the name and residence, including county of the owner of such motor vehicle; (C-1) WITH RESPECT TO VEHICLES SUBJECT REGISTRATION PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION SIX, PARAGRAPH ONE OF SCHEDULE B AND SCHEDULE C OF SUBDIVISION SEVEN OF THIS SECTION, SPACE ON THE APPLI-CATION AND RENEWAL APPLICATION TO ENABLE THE APPLICANT TO DECLINE REGIS-TRATION IN THE NEW YORK STATE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY PURSUANT TO SUBDIVI-TWO-A OF SECTION FORTY-THREE HUNDRED TEN OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW,

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [ ] is old law to be omitted.

AS INDICATED BY CHECKING "NO" TO REGISTRATION IN SUCH REGISTRY AND SPACE

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FOR THE APPLICANT'S SIGNATURE WITHIN A DESIGNATED AREA (SEPARATE FROM FINAL SIGNATURE CERTIFYING THE VALIDITY OF THE INFORMATION PROVIDED 3 IN THE OVERALL APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION). DECLINING TO YORK STATE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY UNDER THIS SECTION BY MARKING 5 THE "NO" BOX ON THE APPLICATION AND SEPARATELY SIGNING SHALL BE DEEMED A 6 SHOWING THAT THE APPLICANT HAS DECLINED THE AUTHORIZATION PURSUANT TO 7 SUBDIVISION TWO-A OF SECTION FORTY-THREE HUNDRED TEN OF THE PUBLIC 8 HEALTH LAW; (d) provided that, if such motor vehicle is used or used as an omnibus, the applicant also shall so certify, and in the case 9 10 an omnibus also certify as to the seating capacity, and if the omni-11 bus is to be operated wholly within a municipality pursuant to a franchise other than a franchise express or implied in articles of incorpo-12 13 ration upon certain streets designated in such franchise, those facts 14 shall also be certified, and a certified copy of such franchise 15 furnished to the commissioner; (e) provided, that, if such motor vehicle 16 is an altered livery, the applicant shall so furnish a certified copy of 17 the length of the center panel of such vehicle, provided, however, that 18 the commissioner shall require such proof, as he may determine is neces-19 sary, in the application for registration and provided further, if the 20 center panel of such vehicle exceeds one hundred inches, the commission-21 er shall require proof that such vehicle is in compliance with all 22 applicable federal and state motor vehicle safety standards; and (f) 23 such additional facts or evidence as the commissioner may require in connection with the application for registration. 24 Every owner of a 25 trailer shall also make application for the registration thereof in the 26 manner herein provided for an application to register a motor vehicle, 27 but shall contain a statement showing the manufacturer's number or other 28 identification satisfactory to the commissioner and no number plate trailer issued under the provisions of subdivision three of section 29 four hundred two of this chapter shall be transferred to or used upon 30 any other trailer than the one for which number plate is issued. The 31 32 commissioner shall require proof, in the application for registration, 33 or otherwise, as such commissioner may determine, that the motor vehicle for which registration is applied for is equipped with lights conforming 34 in all respects to the requirements of this chapter, and no motor vehi-35 cle shall be registered unless it shall appear by such proofs that 36 37 motor vehicle is equipped with proper lights as aforesaid. The said 38 application shall contain or be accompanied by such evidence of ownership of the motor vehicle described in the application as may be 39 40 required by the commissioner or his agent and which, with respect to new vehicles, shall include, unless otherwise specifically provided by the 41 42 commissioner, the manufacturer's statement of origin. Applications 43 received by an agent of the commissioner shall be forwarded to 44 commissioner as he shall direct for filing. No application for registra-45 tion shall be accepted unless the applicant is at least sixteen years of 46 age. 47

- S 3. Subdivision 3 of section 401 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new paragraph e to read as follows:
- E. IN PROCESSING ANY APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION OF THEREOF PURSUANT THIS ARTICLE OR TO TITLE ELEVEN OF THIS RENEWAL TO CHAPTER, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROVIDE APPLICANTS WITH INFORMATIONAL TISSUE DONATION, MATERIALS DESCRIBING ORGAN AND THE NEW YORK STATE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY FOR ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATIONS (WITH INFORMATION FOR SUCH REGISTRY INCLUDING ITS MAILING AND WEBSITE ADDRESSES), AND THE "LIFE PASS IT ON" FUND. TRUST SUCH

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MATERIALS SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AT THE FIRST OPPORTUNITY AND PERIODICALLY THEREAFTER.

- S 4. Paragraph a of subdivision 3 of section 401 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by section 1 of part H of chapter 59 of the laws of 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 a. Upon filing of such application and the payment of the fee herein-7 after provided, the commissioner shall assign to such motor vehicle a distinctive number and, without expense to the applicant, issue and deliver in such manner as the commissioner may select to the owner a 9 10 certificate of registration, in such form as the commissioner 11 prescribe, and two number plates at a place within the state of New York 12 named by the applicant in his or her application. EVERY CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION ISSUED FOR A VEHICLE REGISTERED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION SIX 13 14 OR PARAGRAPH ONE OF SCHEDULE B AND SCHEDULE C OF SUBDIVISION 15 THIS SECTION TO A PERSON MAKING AN ANATOMICAL GIFT SHALL HAVE PROMINENT-16 LY PRINTED UPON THE FRONT OF SUCH CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION OR RENEWAL 17 STATEMENT "ORGAN DONOR" IN NOTABLY DISTINCTIVE PRINT OR THEREOF THE 18 FORMAT. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL NOT REQUIRE FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH 19 REGISTRATION OR RENEWAL THEREOF TO PERSONS MAKING AN ANATOMICAL 20 WHICH ARE DIFFERENT FROM THE FEES REQUIRED FOR THE ISSUANCE OF REGISTRA-TIONS OR RENEWALS THEREOF TO PERSONS NOT MAKING AN ANATOMICAL GIFT. A 21 22 number plate, within the meaning of this chapter, may, in the discretion 23 of the commissioner, be a plate of a permanent nature, treated with reflectorized material according to specifications prescribed by the 24 25 commissioner, and with a date tag attached to such plate or to the vehi-26 cle as prescribed by regulations of the commissioner indicating the validity of the plate during a certain period and the issuance of such a 27 28 number plate with such date tag to a person possessing such a number 29 plate shall be deemed the issuance of a number plate. An additional fee, not to exceed twenty-five dollars, shall be paid to the commissioner 30 whenever a set of reflectorized number plates is issued for any vehicle 31 32 for which a registration fee is normally charged except that, with 33 respect to any number plate which is specifically requested by the applicant, such fee shall be paid to the commissioner upon approval of 34 such request. In the event of the loss, mutilation or destruction of any 35 certificate of registration, any number plate or set of number plates 36 37 whether with or without a date tag or tags, or any date tag or set of 38 date tags provided for in this article, the owner of a registered motor vehicle may file such statement and proof of the facts as the commis-39 40 sioner shall require, with a fee of three dollars, in the office of the commissioner, or, unless and until the commissioner shall otherwise 41 direct, in the office of the agent who issued the certificate, plate, 42 43 plates, tag or tags and the commissioner or his or her agent, as case may be, shall issue a duplicate or substitute. It shall be the duty 44 of every owner holding a certificate of registration to notify the commissioner in writing of any change of residence of such person within 45 46 47 ten days after such change occurs, and to inscribe on such certificate, 48 the place provided by the commissioner, a record of such change of 49 residence.
  - S 5. Section 401 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 20 to read as follows:
  - 20. THE COMMISSIONER IS DIRECTED TO DEVELOP REGISTRATION APPLICATION AND RENEWAL FORMS WHICH SHALL SOLICIT A VOLUNTARY TWO DOLLAR DONATION FROM PERSONS APPLYING FOR OR RENEWING A VEHICLE REGISTRATION AT THE TIME OF SUCH APPLICATION OR RENEWAL. OF MONIES COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION, THE FIRST ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS SHALL BE

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RETAINED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO OFFSET ITS INITIAL PROGRAM COSTS. SUBSE-QUENTLY, FIVE PERCENT OF ANY MONIES COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE RETAINED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR CONTINUING ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS. THE REMAINDER OF SUCH MONIES COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE "LIFE PASS IT ON" TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SECTION NINETY-FIVE-D OF THE STATE FINANCE LAW, AS ADDED BY CHAPTER FOUR HUNDRED FIFTEEN OF THE LAWS OF TWO THOUSAND THREE.

- S 6. Subdivision 1 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 639 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as follows:
- 1. Application for license. Application for a driver's license shall be made to the commissioner. The fee prescribed by law may be submitted with such application. The applicant shall furnish such proof of identity, age, and fitness as may be required by the commissioner. The commissioner may also provide that the application procedure shall include the taking of a photo image or images of the applicant in accordance with rules and regulations prescribed by the commissioner. In addition, commissioner also shall require that the applicant provide his or her social security number and provide space on the application so that the applicant may [register] DECLINE REGISTRATION in the New York state organ and tissue donor registry under section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law, AS INDICATED BY CHECKING "NO" TO REGISTRATION SUCH REGISTRY TOGETHER WITH THE APPLICANT'S SIGNATURE WITHIN A DESIG-NATED AREA (SEPARATE FROM THE FINAL SIGNATURE CERTIFYING THE VALIDITY OF THE INFORMATION PROVIDED IN THE OVERALL APPLICATION). DECLINING IN THE NEW YORK STATE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY UNDER THIS SECTION BY MARKING THE "NO" BOX ON THE APPLICATION AND SEPARATELY SIGNING SHALL DEEMED A SHOWING THAT THE APPLICANT HAS DENIED THE AUTHORIZATION PURSU-ANT TO SUBDIVISION TWO-A OF SECTION FORTY-THREE HUNDRED TENPUBLIC HEALTH LAW. In addition, an applicant for a commercial driver's license who will operate a commercial motor vehicle in interstate commerce shall certify that such applicant meets the requirements to operate a commercial motor vehicle, as set forth in public law 99-570, title XII, and title 49 of the code of federal regulations, and all regulations promulgated by the United States secretary of transportation under the hazardous materials transportation act. Upon a determination that the holder of a commercial driver's license has made any false statement, with respect to the application for such license, the commissioner shall revoke such license.
- 5. The commissioner is directed to develop license application and renewal forms which shall solicit a voluntary [one] TWO dollar donation from persons applying for or renewing a driver's license at the time of such application or renewal. Of monies collected pursuant to this subdivision, the first one hundred fifty thousand dollars shall be retained by the department to offset its initial program costs. Subsequently, five percent of any monies collected pursuant to this subdivision shall be retained by the department for continuing administrative costs. The remainder of such monies collected pursuant to this subdivision shall be

49 be retained by the department for continuing administrative costs. The 50 remainder of such monies collected pursuant to this subdivision shall be 51 deposited in the life pass it on trust fund established pursuant to 52 gostion ninety five d of the state finance law as added by chapter four

S 7. Subdivision 5 of section 508 of the vehicle and traffic

52 section ninety-five-d of the state finance law, as added by chapter four 53 hundred fifteen of the laws of two thousand three.

S 8. Section 508 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 6 to read as follows:

IN PROCESSING ANY APPLICATION FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR RENEWAL THEREOF PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE OR TO TITLE ELEVEN OF THIS CHAPTER, THE SHALL PROVIDE APPLICANTS WITHCOMMISSIONER INFORMATIONAL DESCRIBING ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATION, THE NEW YORK STATE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY FOR ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATIONS (WITH CURRENT CONTACT INFORMA-TION FOR SUCH REGISTRY INCLUDING ITS MAILING AND WEBSITE ADDRESSES), AND THE "LIFE PASS IT ON" TRUST FUND. SUCH INFORMATIONAL MATERIALS SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AT THE FIRST OPPORTUNITY AND PERIODICALLY THEREAFTER.

- S 9. Subdivision 2 of section 95-d of the state finance law, as added by chapter 415 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 2. Such fund shall consist of all revenues received pursuant to the provisions of SUBDIVISION TWENTY OF SECTION FOUR HUNDRED ONE, section four hundred four-u, AND SUBDIVISION FIVE OF SECTION FIVE HUNDRED EIGHT of the vehicle and traffic law and all other moneys appropriated, credited, or transferred thereto from any other fund or source pursuant to law. Nothing contained in this section shall prevent the state from receiving grants, gifts or bequests for the purposes of the fund as defined in this section and depositing them into the fund according to law.
- S 10. Subdivision 2 of section 4310 of the public health law, as amended by chapter 161 of the laws of 2010, is amended and a new subdivision 2-a is added to read as follows:
- 2. Such registration of consent to make an anatomical gift can be made [through] (a) [indication made on the application or renewal form of] AUTOMATICALLY THROUGH APPLYING FOR A RENEWING a license AND/OR VEHICLE REGISTRATION, (b) THROUGH indication made on a non-driver identification card application or renewal form, (c) BY enrolling in the registry website maintained by the department, which may include using an electronic signature under regulations of the commissioner and subject to article three of the state technology law, (d) THROUGH indication made on a voter registration form pursuant to subdivision five of section 5-210 of the election law, or (e) through any other method identified by the commissioner. The registration shall take effect upon the department sending written notice of the registration to the person enrolling in the registry. In making regulations on using an electronic signature for a registration of consent, the commissioner shall consult with the director of the office of technology.
- 2-A. ANY PERSON FILING WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES AN APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OR RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH B OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION FOUR HUNDRED ONE OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW AND/OR AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE OR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION FIVE HUNDRED TWO OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW MAY DECLINE REGISTRATION IN THE NEW YORK STATE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY BY CHECKING "NO" TO REGISTRATION IN SUCH REGISTRY AND AFFIXING HIS OR HER SIGNATURE WITHIN A DESIGNATED AREA ON SUCH APPLICATION (SEPARATE FROM THE FINAL SIGNATURE CERTIFYING THE VALIDITY OF THE INFORMATION PROVIDED IN THE OVERALL APPLICATION).
- S 11. Section 4303 of the public health law is amended by adding two new subdivisions 6 and 7 to read as follows:
- 6. FOR ALL ANATOMICAL GIFTS MADE UNDER THIS ARTICLE OR ARTICLE FOUR-TEEN OR ARTICLE NINETEEN OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW, THE DONOR WILL BE PRESUMED TO MAKE A DONATION OF ANY AND ALL ORGANS AND TISSUES; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT THIS PRESUMPTION SHALL NOT APPLY WHEN:
- (A) THE DONOR HAS EXPRESSLY STATED HIS OR HER INTENTION IN WRITING, TO GIFT A SPECIFIC ORGAN OR ORGANS AND/OR TISSUE OR TISSUES. AN EXPRESS

GIFT OF A SPECIFIC ORGAN OR ORGANS AND/OR TISSUE OR TISSUES SHALL DEFEAT THE PRESUMPTION OF THIS SECTION EVEN IN THE ABSENCE OF LANGUAGE THAT IS NOT OTHERWISE INCONSISTENT WITH THIS SECTION;

- (B) THE DONOR HAS EXPRESSLY STATED HIS OR HER INTENTION TO THE NEW YORK STATE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY. ANY COMMUNICATION, INCLUDING WRITTEN, ORAL, SIGN LANGUAGE, ELECTRONIC OR OTHERWISE, THAT CONTRADICTS OR OTHERWISE CONFLICTS WITH THE PRESUMPTION OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE SUFFICIENT TO OVERCOME THE PRESUMPTION OF THIS SECTION;
  - (C) THE DONOR REVOKES HIS OR HER GIFT;
- (D) THE DONOR IS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN, IN WHICH CASE THE DONOR'S LEGAL GUARDIAN SHALL MAKE THE FINAL DONATION DECISION;
- (E) THE GIFT IS MADE PURSUANT TO ARTICLE FOURTEEN OR NINETEEN OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW AND THE DONOR HAS LISTED A SPECIFIC ORGAN OR ORGANS AND/OR TISSUE OR TISSUES. ANY MARK MADE ON THE DONOR'S LICENSE OR VEHICLE REGISTRATION OR THE DONOR'S APPLICATION FOR LICENSE OR REGISTRATION OR APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF LICENSE OR REGISTRATION THAT INDICATES THE DONOR INTENDS TO MAKE A SPECIFIC GIFT OF ORGAN OR ORGANS AND/OR TISSUE OR TISSUES SHALL DEFEAT THE PRESUMPTION OF THIS SECTION;
- (F) THE DONATION IS PROHIBITED BY SECTION FORTY-THREE HUNDRED SEVEN OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 7. THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES SHALL PROVIDE PRINTED INFORMATIONAL MATERIAL TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, POSTERS, ENROLLMENT FORMS AND OTHER INFORMATIONAL LITERATURE INFORMING THE GENERAL PUBLIC ABOUT ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATION, THE NEW YORK STATE DONATE LIFE REGISTRY FOR ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATIONS INCLUDING CURRENT MAILING AND WEBSITE ADDRESSES FOR SUCH REGISTRY, AND THE "LIFE PASS IT ON" TRUST FUND. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL MAKE SUCH INFORMATIONAL MATERIALS AVAILABLE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC AT ALL DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLE OFFICES, ALL COUNTY OFFICES THAT PROVIDE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLE SERVICES, AND ON THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES' WEBSITE.
- 31 S 12. This act shall take effect November 1, 2012.
