AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to requiring providers of non-emergency, clinical outpatient treatment to check whether patients are sex offenders and to segregate sex offender patients from other patients

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section 33.27 to read as follows:

- S 33.27 REQUIREMENT TO CHECK SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY; CONTINUING CLINICAL OUTPATIENT TREATMENT.
  - (A) EVERY FACILITY AND PROGRAM OPERATED OR CERTIFIED BY ANY OFFICE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HYGIENE, WHICH PROVIDES A NON-EMERGENCY, CLIN-ICAL OUTPATIENT COURSE OF TREATMENT TO A PATIENT, WHICH REQUIRES THREE OR MORE VISITS DURING ANY CALENDAR YEAR, SHALL REQUIRE EACH SUCH PATIENT PROVIDE HIS OR HER ADDRESS AND DATE OF BIRTH, AND INQUIRE WHETHER SUCH PATIENT IS A SEX OFFENDER, AS DEFINED BY SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT-A OF THE CORRECTION LAW. ΙN ADDITION, FACILITY OR PROGRAM SHALL CALL THE SPECIAL TELEPHONE NUMBER, OPERATED BY SERVICES PURSUANT DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE TO SECTION ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT-P OF THE CORRECTION LAW, TO DETERMINE WHETHER SUCH PATIENT IS A SEX OFFENDER.
  - (B) EVERY FACILITY AND PROGRAM OPERATED OR CERTIFIED BY ANY OFFICE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HYGIENE, WHICH PROVIDES A NON-EMERGENCY, CLIN-ICAL OUTPATIENT COURSE OF TREATMENT TO A PATIENT, WHICH REQUIRES THREE OR MORE VISITS DURING ANY CALENDAR YEAR, SHALL SCHEDULE AND TREAT PATIENTS WHO ARE SEX OFFENDERS DURING AND AT SUCH TIMES AS NO PATIENTS WHO ARE NOT SEX OFFENDERS ARE WITHIN ANY PORTION OF THE FACILITY OR PROGRAM IN WHICH TREATMENT IS PROVIDED.
- 23 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 24 have become a law.
