AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to remote net metering by farm and non-residential customer-generators

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 66-j of the public service law is 1 amended by adding a new paragraph (e) to read as follows:

(E) A CUSTOMER WHO OWNS OR OPERATES A FARM OPERATION AS SUCH TERM

IN SUBDIVISION ELEVEN OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED ONE OF THE AGRI-CULTURE AND MARKETS LAW, OR A NON-RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER-GENERATOR AS SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF PARAGRAPH (A) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF DEFINED BY 7 THIS SECTION THAT LOCATES SOLAR ELECTRIC GENERATING EQUIPMENT ELECTRIC GENERATING EOUIPMENT WITH A NET ENERGY METER ON PROPERTY 9 OWNED OR LEASED BY SUCH CUSTOMER-GENERATOR MAY DESIGNATE 10 PORTION OF THE NET METERING CREDITS GENERATED BY SUCH EQUIPMENT TO 11 METERS AT ANY PROPERTY OWNED OR LEASED BY SUCH CUSTOMER-GENERATOR WITHIN 12 THE SERVICE TERRITORY OF THE SAME ELECTRIC CORPORATION TO WHICH THE 13 CUSTOMER-GENERATOR'S NET ENERGY METERS ARE INTERCONNECTED AND BEING WITHIN THE SAME LOAD ZONE AS DETERMINED BY THE LOCATION 14 BASED DATE OF INITIAL REQUEST BY THE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR TO 15 PRICE AS OF THETHE ELECTRIC CORPORATION WILL CREDIT THE ACCOUNTS 16 CONDUCT NET METERING. 17 OF THE CUSTOMER BY APPLYING ANY CREDITS TO THE HIGHEST USE METER FIRST,

THEN SUBSEQUENT HIGHEST USE METERS UNTIL ALL SUCH CREDITS ARE ATTRIBUTED 19 TO THE CUSTOMER. ANY EXCESS CREDITS SHALL BE CARRIED OVER TO THE FOLLOW-

1 S 2. Subdivision 3 of section 66-1 of the public service law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph (e) to read as follows:

(E) A CUSTOMER WHO OWNS OR OPERATES LAND USED IN AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION FOUR OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED ONE 5 OF THE AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS LAW, OR A NON-RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER-GENER-ATOR AS DEFINED BY PARAGRAPH (C-1) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION 6 7 THAT LOCATES WIND ELECTRIC GENERATING EQUIPMENT WITH A NET ENERGY METER ON PROPERTY OWNED OR LEASED BY SUCH CUSTOMER-GENERATOR MAY DESIGNATE ALL 8 9 A PORTION OF THE NET METERING CREDITS GENERATED BY SUCH EQUIPMENT TO 10 METERS, AT ANY PROPERTY OWNED OR LEASED BY SUCH CUSTOMER-GENERATOR WITH-IN THE SERVICE TERRITORY OF THE SAME ELECTRIC CORPORATION TO WHICH 11 CUSTOMER-GENERATOR'S NET ENERGY METERS ARE INTERCONNECTED AND BEING 12 WITHIN THE SAME LOAD ZONE AS DETERMINED BY THE LOCATION BASED 13 MARGINAL 14 PRICE AS OF THE DATE OF INITIAL REQUEST BY THE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR TO CONDUCT NET METERING. THE ELECTRIC CORPORATION WILL CREDIT THE ACCOUNTS 15 OF THE CUSTOMER BY APPLYING ANY CREDITS TO THE HIGHEST USE METER FIRST, 16 THEN SUBSEQUENT HIGHEST USE METERS UNTIL ALL SUCH CREDITS ARE ATTRIBUTED 17 TO THE CUSTOMER. ANY EXCESS CREDITS SHALL BE CARRIED OVER TO THE FOLLOW-18 19 ING MONTH.

20 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
