AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to directing clinical laboratories to provide results of tests directly to the person on whom the test was performed

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2 576-d to read as follows:

3 S 576-D. RELEASE OF TEST RESULTS TO PATIENTS. 1. A CLINICAL LABORATORY 4 SHALL, UPON REQUEST, REPORT THE RESULTS OF ANY TEST, EXAMINATION OR 5 ANALYSIS OF A SPECIMEN SUBMITTED FOR EVIDENCE OF HUMAN DISEASE OR 6 MEDICAL CONDITION DIRECTLY TO THE PERSON ON WHOM THE TEST WAS PERFORMED, 7 IN ADDITION TO THE PHYSICIAN WHO ORDERED SUCH TEST OR EXAMINATION.

8 NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL AUTHORIZE A CLINICAL LABORATORY TO 2. ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF ANY HEALTH CARE PROFESSION UNDER 9 TITLE EIGHT THE EDUCATION LAW. THE REPORT ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL 10 OF CONTAIN A CLEAR STATEMENT, PRESENTED IN A PROMINENT MANNER, 11 TO THE EFFECT THAT THE REPORT SHOULD NOT BE VIEWED AS MEDICAL ADVICE AND IS NOT 12 13 MEANT TO REPLACE DIRECT COMMUNICATION WITH A PHYSICIAN OR OTHER HEALTH 14 CARE PRACTITIONER.

15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
