AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the employment of police officers in the town of Southampton; and to repeal certain provisions of such law relating thereto

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision m of section 384-d of the retirement and social security law is REPEALED and a new subdivision m is added to read as follows:

M. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY INCONSISTENT PROVISION OF LAW, IF THE THE TOWN OF SOUTHAMPTON ELECTS TO MAKE THE BENEFITS OF THIS SECTION AVAILABLE TO THE MEMBERS OF ITS POLICE DEPARTMENT, EACH MEMBER SHALL BE SEPARATED FROM SERVICE UPON COMPLETION OF SUCH DEPARTMENT TWENTY YEARS OF SERVICE, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THATTHETOWN BOARD TO CONTINUE IN SERVICE ON AN ANNUAL BASIS AFTER THE PERMIT A MEMBER COMPLETION OF TWENTY YEARS OF SERVICE, BUT IN NO EVENT SHALL SUCH ANNUAL SERVICE BE CONTINUED AFTER A MEMBER HAS ATTAINED AGE FIFTY-FIVE NOT ATTAINED TWENTY YEARS OF SERVICE, EXCEPT HOWEVER, SUCH MEMBER HAS

- 12 SUCH MEMBER HAS NOT ATTAINED TWENTY YEARS OF SERVICE, EXCEPT HOWEVER, 13 THAT MEMBERS OF SUCH DEPARTMENT WHO HOLD THE RANK OF SERGEANT OR HIGHER
- 13 THAT MEMBERS OF SUCH DEPARTMENT WHO HOLD THE RANK OF SERGEANT OR HIGHER 14 WITHIN SUCH DEPARTMENT MAY BE PERMITTED BY THE TOWN BOARD TO REMAIN IN
- 15 SERVICE UNTIL THE MEMBER HAS ATTAINED AGE SIXTY.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

FISCAL NOTE. -- Pursuant to Legislative Law, Section 50:

This bill will amend Subdivision (m) of Section 384-d of the Retirement and Social Security Law so as to not force a police officer employed by the Town of Southampton to retire after attaining age 55 without 20 years of service.

If this bill is enacted, there will be no cost.
