AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the department of homeless services to maintain an intake center in Manhattan

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The administrative code of the city of New York is amended
2 by adding a new section 21-316 to read as follows:
3 S 21-316. INTAKE FOR SINGLE MEN. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAINTAIN A
4 FACILITY IN MANHATTAN, WHICH SHALL BE OPEN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS A DAY,
5 SEVEN DAYS A WEEK, TO ACCEPT AND PROCESS APPLICATIONS FOR SHELTER FROM
6 SINGLE HOMELESS MEN. ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO IS IN THE PROCESS OF APPLYING
7 FOR SHELTER AS OF TEN O'CLOCK IN THE EVENING ON THE DAY SUCH INDIVIDUAL
8 SOUGHT SHELTER SHALL BE PROVIDED TEMPORARY SHELTER PLACEMENT FOR THAT
9 NIGHT, AT THAT FACILITY. THE FACILITY SHALL HAVE A GREATER CAPACITY TO
10 SHELTER SINGLE HOMELESS MEN THAN ANY OTHER INTAKE FACILITY IN THE CITY.
11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall
12 have become a law.
