Introduced by Sens. OPPENHEIMER, DIAZ, KRUEGER -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Housing, Construction and Community Development

AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York and the emergency tenant protection act of nineteen seventy-four, in relation to registration and repealing certain provisions of such code and such act relating thereto

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision e of section 26-517 of the administrative code
2 of the city of New York is REPEALED and a new subdivision e is added to
3 read as follows:

4 E. AN OWNER WHO FAILS TO REGISTER A HOUSING ACCOMMODATION SUBJECT TO
5 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE PROHIBITED FROM COLLECTING ANY
6 RENT ON AN UNREGISTERED UNIT FOR ANY PERIOD DURING WHICH IT IS UNREGIS-
7 TERED.

8 S 2. Subdivision e of section 12-a of section 4 of chapter 576 of the
9 laws of 1974, constituting the emergency tenant protection act of nine-
10 teen seventy-four, is REPEALED and a new subdivision e is added to read
11 as follows:

12 E. AN OWNER WHO FAILS TO REGISTER A HOUSING ACCOMMODATION SUBJECT TO
13 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE PROHIBITED FROM COLLECTING ANY
14 RENT ON AN UNREGISTERED UNIT FOR ANY PERIOD DURING WHICH IT IS UNREGIS-
15 TERED.

16 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately provided that the amend-
17 ment to section 26-517 of the rent stabilization law of nineteen hundred
18 sixty-nine made by section one of this act shall expire on the same date
19 as such law expires and shall not affect the expiration of such law as
20 provided under section 26-520 of such law and provided further that the
21 amendment to section 12-a of the emergency tenant protection act of
22 nineteen seventy-four made by section two of this act shall expire on
23 the same date as such act expires and shall not affect the expiration of
24 such act as provided in section 17 of chapter 576 of the laws of 1974,
25 as amended.
