AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to mandatory registration or declination of registration in the New York state organ and tissue donor registry on motor vehicle license applications

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Lauren's Law".  
2     S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law, as  
3 amended by chapter 639 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as  
4 follows:  
5     1. Application for license. Application for a driver's license shall  
6 be made to the commissioner. The fee prescribed by law may be submitted  
7 with such application. The applicant shall furnish such proof of identi-  
8 ty, age, and fitness as may be required by the commissioner. The commis-  
9 sioner may also provide that the application procedure shall include the  
10 taking of a photo image or images of the applicant in accordance with  
11 rules and regulations prescribed by the commissioner. In addition, the  
12 commissioner also shall require that the applicant provide his or her  
13 social security number [and provide]. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ENSURE THAT  
14 space IS PROVIDED on the application so that the applicant [may] SHALL  
15 register OR DECLINE REGISTRATION in the New York state DONATE LIFE  
16 REGISTRY FOR organ and tissue [donor registry] DONATIONS under section  
17 forty-three hundred ten of the public health law AND THAT THE FOLLOWING  
18 IS STATED ON THE APPLICATION: "WOULD YOU LIKE TO BE ADDED TO THE DONATE  
19 LIFE REGISTRY? CHECK BOX FOR 'YES' OR CHECK BOX FOR 'NO' AT THIS TIME".  
20 In addition, an applicant for a commercial driver's license who will

1 operate a commercial motor vehicle in interstate commerce shall certify  
2 that such applicant meets the requirements to operate a commercial motor  
3 vehicle, as set forth in public law 99-570, title XII, and title 49 of  
4 the code of federal regulations, and all regulations promulgated by the  
5 United States secretary of transportation under the hazardous materials  
6 transportation act. Upon a determination that the holder of a commercial  
7 driver's license has made any false statement, with respect to the  
8 application for such license, the commissioner shall revoke such  
9 license.

10 S 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after  
11 it shall have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediate-  
12 ly, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation  
13 necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are  
14 authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such  
15 effective date.
