AN ACT to amend the workers' compensation law, in relation to coverage
of community emergency response teams

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY,
DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The workers' compensation law is amended by adding a new
2 section 88-d to read as follows:
3 S 88-D. COVERAGE OF COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAMS. 1. THE FOLLOW-
4 ING MUNICIPALITIES THAT EMPLOY COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAMS (CERT)
5 MAY INCLUDE SUCH TEAMS AS EMPLOYEES IN THEIR ARRANGEMENTS AND CONTRACTS
6 WITH THE FUND:
7 TOWN OF NEW CASTLE, COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER.
8 2. COMPENSATIONS PAYABLE UNDER THIS CHAPTER TO COMMUNITY EMERGENCY
9 RESPONSE TEAMS (CERT) SHALL BE PAID FROM THE STATE INSURANCE FUND, AND
10 ALL PAYMENTS TO THE STATE INSURANCE FUND FOR INSURANCE PREMIUMS ON
11 ACCOUNT OF SUCH EMPLOYEES INCLUDING A PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF THE ADMIN-
12 ISTRATIVE EXPENSE OF THE STATE INSURANCE FUND ON ACCOUNT THEREOF SHALL
13 BE PAID OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE TREASURY FROM MONEYS DEPOS-
14 ITED TO THE CREDIT OF THE PUBLIC SERVICES FUND THEREIN.
15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
