AN ACT to amend the workers' compensation law, in relation to coverage of community emergency response teams

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The workers' compensation law is amended by adding a new 2 section 88-d to read as follows:
- S 88-D. COVERAGE OF COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAMS. 1. THE FOLLOW-ING MUNICIPALITIES THAT EMPLOY COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAMS (CERT) MAY INCLUDE SUCH TEAMS AS EMPLOYEES IN THEIR ARRANGEMENTS AND CONTRACTS WITH THE FUND:
- 7 TOWN OF NEW CASTLE, COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER.
- 8 2. COMPENSATIONS PAYABLE UNDER THIS CHAPTER TO COMMUNITY EMERGENCY 9 RESPONSE TEAMS (CERT) SHALL BE PAID FROM THE STATE INSURANCE FUND.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
