AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to contracts for the transportation of pupils in common school districts and union free school districts

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 23 of section 1604 of the education law is 2 amended by adding a new closing paragraph to read as follows:
- WITH RESPECT TO ANY CONTRACT ENTERED INTO PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION, THE DISTRICT SHALL ABIDE BY THE TERMS CONTAINED IN ANY COLLECTIVELY BARGAINED AGREEMENT APPLICABLE TO BUS DRIVERS AND DRIVER'S ASSISTANTS
 ENTERED INTO BY THE CONTRACTING ENTITY, GOVERNING DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS
 AGAINST BUS DRIVERS AND DRIVERS' ASSISTANTS EMPLOYED BY SUCH CONTRACTING
 ENTITY, PRIOR TO THE DISTRICT IMPOSING OR IMPLEMENTING AN ADVERSE DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST SUCH DRIVER OR DRIVER'S ASSISTANT.
- 10 S 2. Subdivision 27 of section 1709 of the education law is amended by 11 adding a new closing paragraph to read as follows:
- 12 WITH RESPECT TO ANY CONTRACT ENTERED INTO PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVI
- 13 SION, THE DISTRICT SHALL ABIDE BY THE TERMS CONTAINED IN ANY COLLECTIVE-
- 14 LY BARGAINED AGREEMENT APPLICABLE TO BUS DRIVERS AND DRIVER'S ASSISTANTS
- 15 ENTERED INTO BY THE CONTRACTING ENTITY, GOVERNING DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS 16 AGAINST BUS DRIVERS AND DRIVERS' ASSISTANTS EMPLOYED BY SUCH CONTRACTING
- 17 ENTITY, PRIOR TO THE DISTRICT IMPOSING OR IMPLEMENTING AN ADVERSE DISCI-
- 18 PLINARY ACTION AGAINST SUCH DRIVER OR DRIVER'S ASSISTANT.
- 19 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
