AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to allowing home schooled children to take certain career education classes at local boards of cooperative educational services districts for free

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 3602-c of the education law is amended by adding a new subdivision 2-d to read as follows:
  - 2-D. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, STUDENTS
- WHO ARE ENTITLED TO ATTEND THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE STATE WITHOUT THE TUITION PURSUANT TO SECTION THIRTY-TWO HUNDRED TWO OF THIS
- CHAPTER, AND WHO ARE HOME SCHOOLED, SHALL, UPON THE WRITTEN REQUEST OF
- 7 PARENT OR PERSON IN PARENTAL RELATION OF ANY SUCH STUDENT, APPLY TO
- 8 THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT INWHICH THE STUDENT RESIDES, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ATTENDING CAREER EDUCATION CLASSES, AS 9
- DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH C OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF 10 THIS SECTION, AT LOCAL
- BOARDS OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES. SUCH REQUESTS SHALL BE FILED 11
- FIRST DAY OF JUNE PRECEDING THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR WHICH THE 12 THE
- REQUEST IS MADE. 13
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 14
