AN ACT to amend the state administrative procedure act, in relation to providing a cure period in regulations affecting small businesses and local governments

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 202-b of the state administrative procedure act is 2 amended by adding a new subdivision 1-a to read as follows:
  - 1-A. IN DEVELOPING A RULE FOR WHICH A REGULATORY FLEXIBILITY ANALYSIS IS REQUIRED AND WHICH INVOLVES THE ESTABLISHMENT OR MODIFICATION OF A VIOLATION OR OF PENALTIES ASSOCIATED WITH A VIOLATION, THE AGENCY SHALL:
- 5 VIOLATION OR OF PENALTIES ASSOCIATED WITH A VIOLATION, THE AGENCY SHALL: 6 (A) INCLUDE A CURE PERIOD OR OTHER OPPORTUNITY FOR AMELIORATIVE ACTION, 7 THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF WHICH WILL PREVENT THE IMPOSITION OF PENAL-
- 8 TIES ON THE PARTY OR PARTIES SUBJECT TO ENFORCEMENT; OR (B) INCLUDE IN 9 THE REGULATORY FLEXIBILITY ANALYSIS AN EXPLANATION OF WHY NO SUCH CURE
- 10 PERIOD WAS INCLUDED IN THE RULE.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of October next succeed-12 ing the date on which it shall have become a law, and shall apply to all
- 13 rules for which a notice of proposed rule making is published on or
- 14 after such date.
