AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to distribution of the state register; and to repeal certain provisions of the executive law relating thereto

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph c of subdivision 1 of section 148 of the execu-
2 tive law is REPEALED.
3 S 2. Subdivisions 2 and 3 of section 148 of the executive law, as
4 amended by chapter 636 of the laws of 1981, are amended and a new subdi-
5 vision 4-a is added to read as follows:
6 2. The department of state shall mail or otherwise deliver a copy of
7 each regular issue and the quarterly index required by subdivision three
8 of section one hundred forty-seven of this article to each agency and
9 every state legislator, UNLESS THE AGENCY OR STATE LEGISLATOR HAS
10 REQUESTED THAT THE DEPARTMENT DISCONTINUE SUCH DELIVERY, and shall
11 provide notice and indicate the availability upon request of any special
12 issue published pursuant to subdivision two of section one hundred
13 forty-seven of this article by placing said notice in the regular issue
14 appearing two weeks prior to the publication date of any such special
15 issue. Such special issues shall be available to each agency and state
16 legislator at no charge.
17 3. Subscriptions to the PRINT VERSION OF THE state register shall be
18 made available to the public by either first or second class mail at the
19 election of the subscriber. A reasonable rate for a subscription to the
20 regular issue and quarterly index required by subdivision three of
21 section one hundred forty-seven of this article, to be not more than
22 eighty dollars per year for first class mail delivery and not more than
23 forty dollars per year for second class mail delivery, shall be set by
24 the secretary of state. The secretary of state may charge no more than

1 one dollar and fifty cents per single copy of a regular issue or quar-
2 terly index of the state register. Rates shall not be set at such a
3 level that the anticipated total subscription revenues exceed the total
4 cost of producing, printing and distributing the state register.

5 4-A. IN ADDITION TO THE PRINT VERSION OF THE STATE REGISTER, THE
6 DEPARTMENT OF STATE SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE AT NO COST AN ONLINE VERSION OF
7 THE WEEKLY STATE REGISTER, QUARTERLY INDEX AND ANY SPECIAL ISSUES AS
8 DIRECTED BY STATUTE OR DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

9 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
