AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to peregrine falcons; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 11-0303 of the environmental conservation law is 2 amended by adding two new subdivisions 4 and 5 to read as follows:
- 4. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL REMOVE THE PEREGRINE FALCON FROM THE NEW YORK STATE ENDANGERED SPECIES LIST AND SHALL NOT LIST THE PEREGRINE FALCON ON THE THREATENED SPECIES LIST.

- 5. THE COMMISSIONER MAY PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS TO ALLOW THE USE OF WILD-CAPTURED PEREGRINE FALCONS FOR FALCONRY UNDER SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE COMMISSIONER, AFTER CONSULTING WITH THE NEW YORK STATE FALCONRY ASSOCIATION, DEEMS REASONABLE.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 11 deemed repealed 10 years after such effective date.
