AN ACT to legalize, validate, ratify and confirm certain transportation contracts of the New Hyde Park-Garden City Park union free school district

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. All acts done and proceedings heretofore had and taken or  
2     caused to be had and taken by the New Hyde Park-Garden City Park union  
3     free school district and by all officers, employees or agents of such  
4     school district relating to or in connection with a transportation  
5     contract for the 2008-2009 school year, in the amount of \$47,160, with  
6     Huntington Coach, and all acts incidental thereto are hereby legalized,  
7     validated, ratified and confirmed, notwithstanding any failure of such  
8     school district to comply with the contract award, approvals and filing  
9     provisions of the education law, general municipal law or any other law  
10    or any other statutory authority, rule or regulation, other than those  
11    filing provisions defined in paragraph a of subdivision 5 of section  
12    3604 of the education law, in relation to any omission, error, defect,  
13    irregularity or illegality in such proceeding had and taken, and  
14    provided further that any amount due and payable to the New Hyde Park-  
15    Garden City Park union free school district as a result of this act  
16    shall be paid pursuant to the provisions of paragraph c of subdivision 5  
17    of section 3604 of the education law.

18    S 2. The education department is hereby directed to consider the costs  
19    of the aforementioned contract set forth in section one of this act for  
20    transportation aid as valid and proper obligations of the New Hyde Park-  
21    Garden City Park union free school district.

22    S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
