- AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to mandatory reporting of abuse of mentally or physically incapacitated persons

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The social services law is amended by adding a new article 1 2 9-C to read as follows: 3 ARTICLE 9-C 4 MANDATORY REPORTING OF ABUSE OF 5 MENTALLY OR PHYSICALLY INCAPACITATED PERSONS б SECTION 473-M. OBLIGATIONS OF PERSONS REQUIRED TO REPORT. 12 473-S. IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY FOR REPORTING. 13 473-T. PENALTIES FOR FAILURE TO REPORT. 473-U. EDUCATION OF MANDATORY REPORTERS. 14 S 473-M. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND PURPOSE. 15 THE LEGISLATURE HEREBY FINDS THAT THE PROBLEM OF ABUSE OF MENTALLY OR PHYSICALLY INCAPACITATED 16 PERSONS IS CONTINUING TO INCREASE IN SOCIETY TODAY. THIS TYPE 17 OF ABUSE 18 OFTEN GOES UNREPORTED BECAUSE OF THE INABILITY OF THE VICTIM TO COMMUNI-19 THE ABUSE TO THE PROPER AUTHORITIES OR THE VICTIM'S UNWILLINGNESS CATE EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [] is old law to be omitted.

1 TO DISCLOSE THE ABUSE DUE TO EMBARRASSMENT, FEAR OR SHAME. THEREFORE, 2 IT IS NECESSARY TO INSTITUTE A SYSTEM WHICH WOULD MAKE THE INDIVIDUALS 3 TREATING OR COMING INTO CONTACT WITH PERSONS WHO HAVE PHYSICAL OR 4 EMOTIONAL SYMPTOMS OF ABUSE RESPONSIBLE FOR REPORTING THIS CRIME TO THE 5 PROPER AUTHORITIES SO THAT THE VICTIMS CAN RECEIVE PROPER PROTECTION 6 FROM FURTHER ABUSE.

7 S 473-N. DEFINITIONS. AS USED IN THIS ARTICLE, THE FOLLOWING TERMS 8 SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING MEANINGS UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES:

9 1. "ABUSE" MEANS THE WILLFUL INFLICTION OF INJURY, UNREASONABLE 10 CONFINEMENT, VERBAL OR MENTAL INTIMIDATION, OR PUNISHMENT RESULTING IN 11 PHYSICAL HARM, PAIN, MENTAL ANGUISH OR FINANCIAL EXPLOITATION.

12 2. "PERSON" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL OVER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN WHO IS 13 MENTALLY OR PHYSICALLY INCAPACITATED TO SUCH A DEGREE AS TO BE UNABLE TO 14 DEFEND HIMSELF OR HERSELF PHYSICALLY OR WHO IS MENTALLY UNABLE TO INDE-15 PENDENTLY CARE FOR HIMSELF OR HERSELF.

16 S 473-O. MANDATORY REPORTING. 1. THE FOLLOWING PERSONS AND OFFICIALS 17 ARE REQUIRED TO REPORT OR CAUSE A REPORT TO BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS ARTICLE WHEN THEY HAVE REASONABLE CAUSE TO SUSPECT THAT A PERSON 18 19 COMING BEFORE THEM IN THEIR PROFESSIONAL OR OFFICIAL CAPACITY IS ABUSED OR MALTREATED, OR WHEN THEY HAVE REASONABLE CAUSE TO SUSPECT THAT A 20 21 PERSON IS ABUSED OR MALTREATED WHERE THE RELATIVE, GUARDIAN, CUSTODIAN 22 OR OTHER PERSON LEGALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR SUCH PERSON COMES BEFORE THEM IN THEIR PROFESSIONAL OR OFFICIAL CAPACITY AND STATES FROM PERSONAL KNOW-23 LEDGE FACTS, CONDITIONS OR CIRCUMSTANCES WHICH, IF CORRECT, WOULD RENDER 24 25 SUCH PERSON AN ABUSED OR MALTREATED INDIVIDUAL: ANY PHYSICIAN; REGIS-26 TERED PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT; SURGEON; MEDICAL EXAMINER; CORONER; DENTIST; 27 DENTAL HYGIENIST; OSTEOPATH; OPTOMETRIST; CHIROPRACTOR; PODIATRIST; RESIDENT; INTERN; PSYCHOLOGIST; REGISTERED NURSE; HOSPITAL PERSONNEL 28 29 ENGAGED IN THE ADMISSION, EXAMINATION, CARE OR TREATMENT OF PERSONS; CERTIFIED EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN; HOME HEALTH CARE PROVIDER; PHYS-30 ICAL THERAPIST; SPEECH THERAPIST; OR OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST; SOCIAL 31 32 SERVICES WORKER; AN ADULT DAY CARE CENTER WORKER; PROVIDER OF ADULT DAY 33 CARE; EMPLOYEE OR VOLUNTEER IN A NURSING HOME AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION 34 ONE OF SECTION TWENTY-EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE-A OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH 35 LAW, PEACE OFFICER; POLICE OFFICER; DISTRICT ATTORNEY OR ASSISTANT INVESTIGATOR EMPLOYED IN THE OFFICE OF A DISTRICT 36 DISTRICT ATTORNEY; 37 ATTORNEY; OR OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL. WHENEVER SUCH PERSON IS 38 REQUIRED TO REPORT UNDER THIS ARTICLE IN HIS OR HER CAPACITY AS A MEMBER 39 OF THE STAFF OF A MEDICAL OR OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE INSTITUTION, FACIL-40 ITY OR AGENCY, HE OR SHE SHALL IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY THE PERSON IN CHARGE OF SUCH INSTITUTION, FACILITY OR AGENCY, OR HIS OR HER DESIGNATED AGENT, 41 WHO THEN ALSO SHALL BECOME RESPONSIBLE TO REPORT OR CAUSE REPORTS TO BE 42 MADE. HOWEVER, NOTHING IN THIS SECTION OR ARTICLE IS INTENDED TO REQUIRE 43 MORE THAN ONE REPORT FROM ANY SUCH INSTITUTION OR AGENCY. 44

45 ANY PERSON, INSTITUTION, FACILITY, AGENCY, ORGANIZATION, PARTNER-2. SHIP OR CORPORATION WHICH EMPLOYS PERSONS MANDATED TO REPORT SUSPECTED 46 47 INCIDENTS OF ABUSE OR MALTREATMENT PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS 48 SECTION SHALL PROVIDE ALL SUCH CURRENT AND NEW EMPLOYEES WITH WRITTEN 49 INFORMATION EXPLAINING THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS AS PROVIDED IN SUBDI-50 VISION ONE OF THIS SECTION AND IN SECTION FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE-Q 51 THIS ARTICLE. THE EMPLOYERS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COSTS ASSO-OF 52 CIATED WITH PRINTING AND DISTRIBUTING WRITTEN INFORMATION.

ANY STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OR AUTHORIZED AGENCY WHICH 54 ISSUES A LICENSE, CERTIFICATE OR PERMIT TO AN INDIVIDUAL TO OPERATE AN 55 ADULT DAY CARE CENTER OR NURSING HOME SHALL PROVIDE EACH PERSON CURRENT-56 LY HOLDING OR SEEKING SUCH A LICENSE, CERTIFICATE OR PERMIT WITH WRITTEN 1 INFORMATION EXPLAINING THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS AS PROVIDED IN SUBDI-2 VISION ONE OF THIS SECTION AND IN SECTION FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE-Q 3 OF THIS ARTICLE.

4 S 473-P. ANY PERSON PERMITTED TO REPORT. IN ADDITION TO THOSE PERSONS 5 AND OFFICIALS REQUIRED TO REPORT SUSPECTED ABUSE OR MALTREATMENT OF 6 MENTALLY OR PHYSICALLY INCAPACITATED PERSONS, ANY PERSON MAY MAKE SUCH A 7 REPORT IF SUCH PERSON HAS REASONABLE CAUSE TO SUSPECT THAT A PERSON IS 8 ABUSED OR MALTREATED.

S 473-O. REPORTING PROCEDURE. REPORTS OF SUSPECTED ABUSE OR MALTREAT-9 10 MENT OF MENTALLY OR PHYSICALLY INCAPACITATED PERSONS MADE PURSUANT ΤO THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE MADE IMMEDIATELY BY TELEPHONE OR BY TELEPHONE 11 12 FACSIMILE MACHINE ON A FORM SUPPLIED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES, TO BE SUCCEEDED BY A WRITTEN REPORT 13 WHICH SHALL 14 INCLUDE, THE NAME AND AGE OF THE ABUSED ADULT; THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF 15 THE FACILITY WHERE THE ABUSED ADULT RESIDES OR IS RECEIVING CARE; THE NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF FAMILY MEMBERS OR ANY OTHER PERSON RESPONSIBLE 16 17 FOR THE CARE OF THE ABUSED ADULT; THE NATURE AND EXTENT OF THE ABUSED ADULT'S INJURIES, INCLUDING ANY EVIDENCE OF PRIOR INJURIES; THE NAME OF 18 19 THE PERSON OR PERSONS ALLEGED TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CAUSING THE INJU-20 RIES, ABUSE OR MALTREATMENT, IF KNOWN; THE NAME OF THE PERSON MAKING THE 21 REPORT AND WHERE HE OR SHE MAY BE REACHED; THE DATE OF THE INCIDENT; THE 22 ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE REPORTING SOURCE, INCLUDING THE TAKING OF X-RAYS AND PHOTOGRAPHS; AND ANY OTHER INFORMATION WHICH THE COMMISSIONER OF 23 CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES MAY, BY REGULATION, REQUIRE OR THE PERSON 24 25 MAKING THE REPORT BELIEVES MIGHT BE HELPFUL, IN FURTHERANCE OF THE 26 PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE. WRITTEN REPORTS FROM PERSONS OR OFFICIALS 27 REQUIRED BY THIS ARTICLE TO REPORT SHALL BE ADMISSIBLE IN EVIDENCE IN 28 PROCEEDINGS RELATING TO ADULT ABUSE OR MALTREATMENT. THESE REPORTS ANY 29 SHALL BE MADE WITHIN TWO BUSINESS DAYS AFTER THE ORAL REPORT, AS 30 FOLLOWS:

1. IF THE SUSPECTED ABUSE IS BELIEVED TO HAVE OCCURRED IN A LONG-TERM
 CARE FACILITY OTHER THAN A STATE MENTAL HEALTH HOSPITAL OR A STATE
 DEVELOPMENTAL CENTER, THE WRITTEN REPORT SHALL BE MADE TO THE OFFICE OF
 CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES.

2. IF THE SUSPECTED ABUSE IS BELIEVED TO HAVE OCCURRED IN A STATE
MENTAL HEALTH HOSPITAL OR A STATE DEVELOPMENTAL CENTER, THE WRITTEN
REPORT SHALL BE MADE EITHER TO THE COMMISSION ON THE QUALITY OF CARE FOR
THE MENTALLY DISABLED OR TO THE QUALITY ASSURANCE DIVISION OF THE OFFICE
OF MENTAL RETARDATION AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES.

IF THE SUSPECTED ABUSE IS BELIEVED TO HAVE OCCURRED IN ANY PLACE 41 OTHER THAN ONE DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION ONE OR TWO OF THIS SECTION, THE 42 WRITTEN REPORT SHALL BE MADE TO THE COUNTY PROTECTIVE ADULT SERVICES 43 OFFICE IN THE COUNTY WHERE THE PERSON RESIDES AND TO LOCAL LAW ENFORCE-44 MENT.

45 S 473-R. OBLIGATIONS OF PERSONS REQUIRED TO REPORT. ANY PERSON OR OFFICIAL REQUIRED TO REPORT CASES OF SUSPECTED ABUSE AND MALTREATMENT OF 46 47 MENTALLY OR PHYSICALLY INCAPACITATED PERSONS MAY TAKE OR CAUSE TO BE 48 TAKEN AT PUBLIC EXPENSE PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE AREAS OF TRAUMA VISIBLE ON 49 THE PERSON WHO IS THE SUBJECT OF THE REPORT AND, IF MEDICALLY INDICATED, 50 TO BE PERFORMED A RADIOLOGICAL EXAMINATION ON SUCH PERSON. ANY CAUSE PHOTOGRAPHS OR X-RAYS TAKEN SHALL BE SENT TO THE BUREAU, COMMISSION, 51 DIVISION OR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT WITH WHICH THE WRITTEN REPORT IS FILED 52 AT THE TIME THE WRITTEN REPORT IS SENT OR AS SOON THEREAFTER AS POSSI-53 54 BLE. WHENEVER SUCH PERSON IS REQUIRED TO REPORT UNDER THIS ARTICLE IN 55 OR HER CAPACITY AS A MEMBER OF THE STAFF OF A MEDICAL OR OTHER HIS PUBLIC OR PRIVATE INSTITUTION, FACILITY OR AGENCY, HE OR SHE SHALL IMME-56

DIATELY NOTIFY THE PERSON IN CHARGE OF SUCH INSTITUTION, FACILITY 1 OR AGENCY, OR HIS OR HER DESIGNATED AGENT, WHO SHALL THEN TAKE OR CAUSE TO 2 3 BE TAKEN AT PUBLIC EXPENSE COLOR PHOTOGRAPHS OF VISIBLE TRAUMA AND 4 SHALL, IF MEDICALLY INDICATED, CAUSE TO BE PERFORMED A RADIOLOGICAL 5 EXAMINATION OF SUCH PERSON. 6 S 473-S.
