AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to access to the wage reporting system

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 171-a of the tax law, as added by chapter 545 of the laws of 1978, is amended by adding a new subdivision 6-b to read as follows:

(6-B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW TO $_{
m THE}$ CONTRARY, COMMISSIONER SHALL ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE COMPTROLLER, WHICH AGREEMENT SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE UTILIZATION OF INFOR-SUBDIVISION MATION OBTAINED PURSUANT TO ONE OF THIS SECTION, PURPOSES OF DETERMINING THE AMOUNT A RETIRED MEMBER OF A RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR PENSION PLAN ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE OR ANY OF ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS WHO RETURNS TO GAINFUL EMPLOYMENT HAS EARNED PURPOSES OF SECTIONS ONE HUNDRED TWO, TWO HUNDRED ELEVEN, TWO HUNDRED TWELVE AND THREE HUNDRED TWO OF THE RETIREMENT AND SOCIAL SECURITY LAW.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

FISCAL NOTE. -- Pursuant to Legislative Law, Section 50:

This bill would give the state Comptroller access to the wage reporting system administered by the department of taxation and finance. This would enable the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System and the New York State and Local Police and Fire Retirement System to verify that retirees who return to work for any public employer are earning less than the limits under Sections 102, 211, 212 and 302 of the Retirement and Social Security Law.

If this bill is enacted, there would be no additional costs. However, utilization of this information could result in the partial recovery of the pensions of any retirees who earn in excess of these limits.
