AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to permitting a hospice to employ and enter into contracts with licensed healthcare providers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 4002 of the public health law is amended by adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:
 - 5. "TERMINALLY ILL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL HAS A MEDICAL PROGNOSIS THAT THE INDIVIDUAL'S LIFE EXPECTANCY IS APPROXIMATELY ONE YEAR OR LESS IF THE ILLNESS RUNS ITS NORMAL COURSE.
 - S 2. Subdivision 3 of section 4008 of the public health law, as added by chapter 416 of the laws of 1983, is amended to read as follows:
- 3. Subject to the provisions of this section and section four thousand ten of this article, contractual agreements between a hospice and other providers of other care and services shall not be prohibited, AND A HOSPICE MAY EMPLOY AND ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH ANY LICENSED HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL OR ANY LAWFUL COMBINATION THEREOF IN RELATION TO SERVICES
- 13 PROVIDED BY THE HOSPICE UNDER THIS ARTICLE, provided that the hospice 14 maintains full responsibility for the planning, coordination and quality
- 14 maintains full responsibility for the planning, coordination and quality 15 of such services and the adherence to the plan of care established for
- 16 the patients.

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17 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
