AN ACT to authorize the town of Thompson, in the county of Sullivan, to establish a special improvement district to be known as the "Lake Louise Marie dam improvement district"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
2 contrary, the town of Thompson, in the county of Sullivan, shall be
3 authorized and enabled to establish a special improvement district to be
4 known as the "Lake Louise Marie dam improvement district". Such district
5 shall be established in accordance with the provisions of articles 12
6 and 12-A of the town law for the establishment, funding and operation of
7 special improvement districts. In particular, and to the extent practi-
8 cable, the Lake Louise Marie dam improvement district shall be subject
9 to the provision of such articles which are applicable to water
10 districts.

11 (b) The purpose of the Lake Louise Marie dam improvement district
12 shall be to provide for the repair, reconstruction and maintenance of
13 the Lake Louise Marie dam and spillway to prevent dam failure or breach.

14 (c) The costs and expenses of the operation of the Lake Louise Marie
15 dam improvement district shall be paid through the levy of special
16 assessments upon all lots or parcels of land within such district either
17 in proportion to the benefit derived therefrom.

18 (d) The town of Thompson and the Lake Louise Marie dam improvement
19 district are hereby authorized to issue bonds and notes pursuant to the
20 provisions of the local finance law applicable to special improvement
21 districts.

22 S 2. Severability. If any provision of this act or the application
23 thereof to any person or circumstance is adjudged invalid by a court of
24 competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or impair any
