AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to the issuance of certificates of relief from disabilities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 702 of the correction law, as amended by section 32 of subpart B of part C of chapter 62 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 1. Any court of this state may, in its discretion, issue a certificate 5 of relief from disabilities to an eligible offender for a conviction that occurred in such court, if the court either (a) imposed a revocable sentence or (b) imposed a sentence other than one executed by commitment 7 an institution under the jurisdiction of the state department of 9 corrections and community supervision. Such certificate may be issued (i) at the time sentence is pronounced, in which case it may grant 10 relief from forfeitures, as well as from disabilities, or (ii) at any 11 12 time thereafter, in which case it shall apply only to disabilities. WHERE SUCH COURT EITHER 13 IMPOSES A REVOCABLE SENTENCE 14 SENTENCE OTHER THAN ONE EXECUTED BY COMMITMENT TO AN INSTITUTION UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND COMMUNITY 15 SUPERVISION, THE COURT, UPON APPLICATION AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBDIVI-16 17 TWO OF THIS SECTION, SHALL INITIALLY DETERMINE THE FITNESS OF AN 18 ELIGIBLE OFFENDER FOR SUCH CERTIFICATE PRIOR TO OR AT THE TIME
