AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to restricting the right of an offender to use a computer in prison or access the internet if such offender has been convicted of certain sex offenses and used a computer in connection with the planning or execution of his or her crime

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 70.80 of the penal law is amended by adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:
- 10. WHENEVER AN OFFENDER CONVICTED OF A FELONY SEX OFFENSE, AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH (A) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION OR A VIOLENT SEX OFFENSE, AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH (B) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION, UTILIZED A COMPUTER OR THE INTERNET IN THEPLANNING EXECUTION OF THE OFFENSE, THE DETERMINATE SENTENCE IMPOSED PURSUANT TO ANY SECTION OF THIS ARTICLE, SHALL INCLUDE AS A PART THEREOF RESTRICTION ON THE RIGHT OF THE OFFENDER TO USE COMPUTERS AND ACCESS THE WHILE SERVING THEIMPOSED SENTENCE. SUCH RESTRICTION SHALL PROHIBIT THE OFFENDER FROM UTILIZING COMPUTERS UNLESS SUPERVISED PERSONNEL OF THE
- 12 PERSONNEL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS, AND FROM ACCESSING THE 13 INTERNET FOR ANY PURPOSE OTHER THAN PERFORMING RESEARCH OR OTHER TASKS
- 14 ASSOCIATED WITH SUCH PERSON'S LEGAL DEFENSE OR PARTICIPATION IN AN
- 15 EDUCATION PROGRAM OR CLASS APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS OF
- 16 FOR COMMUNICATING WITH THE OFFENDER'S FAMILY MEMBERS; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, 17 THAT THE OFFENDER SHALL BE RESTRICTED FROM COMMUNICATING WITH ANY OF HIS
- 18 OR HER VICTIMS. THE OFFENDER SHALL BE RESTRICTED FROM UTILIZING SOCIAL
- 19 NETWORKING SITES DURING THE DURATION OF THE OFFENDER'S TIME I
- 20 DETENTION.
