AN ACT to amend the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, in relation to antitrust exemptions for horse racing agreements

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law is 2 amended by adding a new section 113 to read as follows:
- S 113. ANTITRUST EXEMPTIONS. STATE AND FEDERAL ANTITRUST LAWS NOT APPLY TO ANY JOINT AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO, IN CONSULTATION WITH AND
- 5 APPROVED BY THE STATE RACING AND WAGERING BOARD, BY OR AMONG NON-PROFIT RACING ASSOCIATIONS, THOROUGHBRED RACING ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS,
- 7 HARNESS RACING ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, QUARTER HORSE RACING ASSO-
- CIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, AND REGIONAL OFF-TRACK BETTING CORPORATIONS TO
- 9 COORDINATE THE DATES AND TIMES UNDER WHICH THEY WILL CONDUCT PROGRAMS OF 10 RACING AND OFFER PARI-MUTUEL WAGERING. IN ADDITION, SUCH ANTITRUST LAWS
- 11 SHALL NOT APPLY TO JOINT AGREEMENTS ENTERED INTO, IN CONSULTATION
- APPROVED BY WAGERING BOARD, BY OR AMONG 12 THESTATE RACING AND
- NON-PROFIT RACING ASSOCIATIONS, 13 THOROUGHBRED RACING ASSOCIATIONS
- 14 CORPORATIONS, HARNESS RACING ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, QUARTER HORSE 15
- RACING ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, AND REGIONAL OFF-TRACK BETTING CORPORATIONS TO SELL, TRANSFER, ASSIGN OR PURCHASE THE RIGHTS TO BROAD-16
- SIMULCAST, ELECTRONICALLY TRANSMIT OR OFFER PARI-MUTUEL WAGERING 17
- THE STATE RACING AND WAGERING BOARD SHALL CONSIDER AND 18 ON HORSE RACES. APPROVE SUCH AGREEMENTS AND THE TERMS THEREIN TO FURTHER THE STATE'S 19
- 20 INTEREST IN ENSURING THE VIABILITY AND CONTINUED EXISTENCE IN THIS STATE
- 21 OF THE HORSE RACING AND AGRICULTURE INDUSTRIES.
- 22 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
