- AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to requiring the conducting of a public hearing prior to enacting a local law or resolution to override the tax levy limit

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 3-c of the general municipal law, 2 as added by section 1 of part A of chapter 97 of the laws of 2011, is 3 amended to read as follows:

4 5. A local government may adopt a budget that requires a tax levy that 5 is greater than the tax levy limit for the coming fiscal year, not б including any levy necessary to support the expenditures pursuant to subparagraphs (i) through (iv) of paragraph g of subdivision two of this 7 8 section, only if the governing body of such local government first HOLDS 9 A PUBLIC HEARING UPON THE PROPOSAL TO EXCEED THE TAX LEVY LIMIT AND 10 enacts, by a vote of sixty percent of the total voting power of such body, a local law to override such limit for such coming fiscal year 11 only, or in the case of a district or fire district, a resolution, 12 13 approved by a vote of sixty percent of the total voting power of such body, to override such limit for such coming fiscal year only. 14

15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately, provided that the amend-16 ments to subdivision 5 of section 3-c of the general municipal law, made 17 by section one of this act, shall not affect the expiration and repeal 18 of such section pursuant to section 13 of part A of chapter 97 of the 19 laws of 2011, as amended, and shall expire and be deemed repealed there-20 with.
