AN ACT to amend the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, in relation to antitrust exemptions for horse racing agreements

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

The racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law is 1 Section 1. amended by adding a new section 113-a to read as follows:

3 S 113-A. ANTITRUST EXEMPTIONS. STATE AND FEDERAL ANTITRUST LAWS SHALL APPLY TO ANY JOINT AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO, IN CONSULTATION WITH AND 4 NOT JOINTLY APPROVED BY THE STATE GAMING COMMISSION AND THE ATTORNEY GENER-5 б BY OR AMONG NON-PROFIT RACING ASSOCIATIONS, THOROUGHBRED RACING AL, 7 ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, HARNESS RACING ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPO-RATIONS, QUARTER HORSE RACING ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, AND REGIONAL 8 OFF-TRACK BETTING CORPORATIONS TO COORDINATE THE DATES AND TIMES UNDER 9 10 WHICH THEY WILL CONDUCT PROGRAMS OF RACING AND OFFER PARI-MUTUEL WAGER-IN ADDITION, SUCH ANTITRUST LAWS SHALL NOT APPLY TO JOINT AGREE-11 ING. MENTS ENTERED INTO, IN CONSULTATION WITH AND JOINTLY APPROVED BY 12 THE 13 STATE GAMING COMMISSION AND THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, BY OR AMONG NON-PROFIT THOROUGHBRED RACING ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, 14 RACING ASSOCIATIONS, 15 HARNESS RACING ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, QUARTER HORSE RACING ASSO-CIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS, AND REGIONAL OFF-TRACK BETTING CORPORATIONS TO 16 TRANSFER, ASSIGN OR PURCHASE THE RIGHTS TO BROADCAST, SIMULCAST, 17 SELL, 18 ELECTRONICALLY TRANSMIT OR OFFER PARI-MUTUEL WAGERING ON HORSE RACES. 19 GAMING COMMISSION AND THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL JOINTLY THE STATE 20 CONSIDER AND APPROVE SUCH AGREEMENTS AND THE TERMS THEREIN TO FURTHER 21 STATE'S INTEREST IN ENSURING THE VIABILITY AND CONTINUED EXISTENCE THE IN THIS STATE OF THE HORSE RACING AND AGRICULTURE INDUSTRIES. 22

S 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the 23 same 24 section 1 of part A of chapter 60 of the laws of 2012 takes manner as 25 effect.
