AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to authorizing counties to establish a tax free week in August

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 1225 to read 2 as follows:

S 1225. SALES TAX EXEMPTION. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW TO THE CONTRARY, ANY COUNTY MAY ELECT TO EXEMPT PURCHASES OF GOODS AND MERCHANDISE, EXCLUDING AUTOMOBILES AND GASOLINE, SOLD WITHIN THE COUNTY FROM ANY TAXES IMPOSED PURSUANT TO PART ONE OF THIS ARTICLE FOR A TEN DAY PERIOD IN AUGUST COMMENCING ON A FRIDAY AND ENDING ON A SUNDAY.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
