- AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to exempting uniformed members of emergency services from limitations on post-retirement reemployment

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 211 of the retirement and social security law is 2 amended by adding a new subdivision 9 to read as follows:

3 9. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, ANY UNIFORMED MEMBER OF AN EMERGENCY SERVICE, SUCH MEMBERS INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED 4 TO, POLICE, FIREFIGHTERS, EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS OR A MEMBER OF A 5 CERTIFIED EMERGENCY RESPONSE 6 WHO HAS PREVIOUSLY BEEN TEAM, GRANTED 7 APPROVAL PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION, SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION WHEN SEEKING POST-RETIREMENT REEM-8 PLOYMENT IN ANY POSITION TO WHICH THIS SECTION APPLIES SUBSEQUENT 9 TO 10 SECURING SUCH PREVIOUS APPROVAL.

11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
