AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to residency requirements for certain positions

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 3-b of the public officers law is amended by adding
2 a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:
3 5. NEITHER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION OR OF ANY GENERAL, SPECIAL
4 OR LOCAL LAW, CHARTER, CODE, ORDINANCE, RESOLUTION, RULE OR REGULATION,
5 REQUIRING A PERSON TO BE A RESIDENT OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR
6 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE BY WHICH HE OR SHE IS EMPLOYED OR
7 APPOINTED, SHALL APPLY TO A PERSON EMPLOYED OR APPOINTED BY A POLITICAL
8 SUBDIVISION OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE AS AN AUXILIARY POLICE
9 OFFICER OR SPECIAL DEPUTY SHERIFF, PROVIDED THAT SUCH AUXILIARY POLICE
10 OFFICER OR SPECIAL DEPUTY SHERIFF IS TRAINED AND REGISTERED PURSUANT TO
11 THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE OF THE EXECUTIVE LAW.
12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
