AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to permitting certain motor vehicles on a certain segment of public roads

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 16 of section 385 of the vehicle and traffic 2 law is amended by adding a new paragraph (v) to read as follows:

- (V) WITHIN A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 1.65 MILES FROM EXIT NUMBER 20 OF THE NEW YORK STATE THRUWAY, SUCH DISTANCE TO BE MEASURED IN A SOUTH-EASTERLY DIRECTION FROM THE POINT WHERE STATE ROUTE 32 INTERSECTS WITH THE SOUTHBOUND ACCESS RAMP LEADING TO THE NEW YORK STATE THRUWAY, OVER A ROUTE EXTENDING IN A SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION ON STATE ROUTE 32, AND THEN EASTERLY ALONG US ROUTE 9W FOR A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 0.14 MILES, TO WASHINGTON AVENUE BETWEEN US ROUTE 9W AND RUSSELL STREET, A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 0.13 MILES, AND WEST ON RUSSELL STREET BETWEEN WASHINGTON AVENUE AND THE COTERMINOUS SEGMENT OF US ROUTE 9W AND STATE ROUTE 32, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS PARTITION STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF SAUGERTIES, A
