AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to allowing the use of rifles for hunting big game in a certain portion of the county of Chautauqua

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907  
2 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by section 11 of chap-  
3 ter 483 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows:

26 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately, provided that the amend-  
27 ments to item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of  
28 the environmental conservation law made by section one of this act shall  
29 be subject to the expiration and reversion of such paragraph pursuant to  
30 section 13 of chapter 600 of the laws of 1993, as amended, when upon  
31 such date the provisions of section two of this act shall take effect  
32 and provided, further, that the amendments to item (i) of paragraph a of  
33 subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law  
34 made by section two of this act shall be subject to the expiration and  
35 repeal of such paragraph pursuant to section 17 of chapter 483 of the  
36 laws of 2010, as amended, when upon such date the provisions of section  
37 three of this act shall take effect.
