AN ACT to amend the civil rights law, in relation to civilian complaint review boards

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 50-a of the civil rights law, as 2 amended by section 53 of subpart B of part C of chapter 62 of the laws 3 of 2011, is amended to read as follows:

4 1. All personnel records used to evaluate performance toward continued 5 employment or promotion, under the control of any police agency or department of the state or any political subdivision thereof including б 7 authorities or agencies maintaining police forces of individuals defined as police officers in section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law and 8 such personnel records under the control of a sheriff's department or a 9 10 department of correction of individuals employed as correction officers such personnel records under the control of a paid fire department 11 and 12 or force of individuals employed firefighters as or 13 firefighter/paramedics and such personnel records under the control of the department of corrections and community supervision for individuals 14 15 defined as peace officers pursuant to subdivisions twenty-three and 16 twenty-three-a of section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law shall be 17 considered confidential and not subject to inspection or review without express written consent of such police officer, firefighter, 18 the firefighter/paramedic, correction officer or peace officer within the 19 20 department of corrections and community supervision except as may be 21 lawful court order, AND EXCEPT THAT A MEMBER OF A CIVILIAN mandated by 22 COMPLAINT REVIEW BOARD THAT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR INVESTIGATING POLICE 23 MISCONDUCT MAY PETITION THE COURT FOR AN ORDER PERMITTING DISCLOSURE OF ALL PERSONNEL RECORDS IF THOSE RECORDS RELATE 24 TO AN OFFICER WHO WAS 25 INVOLVED IN A POLICE SHOOTING OR POLICE MISCONDUCT. 26 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
