AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to the heroin and  
opioid addiction wraparound services demonstration program; and  
providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section  
2     19.18-a to read as follows:  
3     S 19.18-A HEROIN AND OPIOID ADDICTION WRAPAROUND SERVICES DEMONSTRATION  
4         PROGRAM.  
5     1. THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH  
6     SHALL DEVELOP A HEROIN AND OPIOID ADDICTION WRAPAROUND SERVICES DEMON-  
7     STRATION PROGRAM. THIS PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE WRAPAROUND SERVICES TO  
8     ADOLESCENT AND ADULT PATIENTS DURING TREATMENT AND SHALL BE AVAILABLE TO  
9     SUCH PATIENTS FOR A CLINICALLY APPROPRIATE PERIOD FOR UP TO NINE MONTHS  
10    AFTER COMPLETION OF SUCH TREATMENT PROGRAM. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL IDEN-  
11    TIFY AND ESTABLISH WHERE THE WRAPAROUND SERVICES DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM  
12    WILL BE PROVIDED.  
13    2. WRAPAROUND SERVICES SHALL INCLUDE;  
14    (A) CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES WHICH ADDRESS:  
15    (I) EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES;  
16    (II) LEGAL SERVICES;  
17    (III) FINANCIAL SERVICES;  
18    (IV) SOCIAL SERVICES;  
19    (V) FAMILY SERVICES; AND  
20    (VI) CHILDCARE SERVICES;  
21    (B) PEER SUPPORTS, INCLUDING PEER TO PEER SUPPORT GROUPS;  
22    (C) EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT; AND

EXPLANATION--Matter in *ITALICS* (underscored) is new; matter in brackets  
[ ] is old law to be omitted.

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1 (D) TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE.

2 3. NOT LATER THAN TWO YEARS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION,  
3 THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROVIDE THE GOVERNOR, THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF  
4 THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, THE CHAIR OF THE SENATE STAND-  
5 ING COMMITTEE ON ALCOHOLISM AND DRUG ABUSE AND THE CHAIR OF THE ASSEMBLY  
6 COMMITTEE ON ALCOHOLISM AND DRUG ABUSE WITH A WRITTEN EVALUATION OF THE  
7 DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM. SUCH EVALUATION SHALL ADDRESS THE OVERALL EFFEC-  
8 TIVENESS OF THIS DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM AND WHETHER CONTINUATION OR  
9 EXPANSION OF THIS DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM IS RECOMMENDED.

10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be  
11 deemed repealed three years after such effective date.
