AN ACT to amend the state technology law, in relation to the creation of a state information technology innovation center

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The state technology law is amended by adding a new section 2 103-a to read as follows:
  - S 103-A. STATE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INNOVATION CENTER. 1. THE DIRECTOR MAY OPERATE A STATE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INNOVATION CENTER OR "ICENTER" TO DEVELOP AND DEMONSTRATE TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS WITH POTENTIAL BENEFIT TO THE STATE AND ITS CITIZENS. THE ICENTER MAY FACILITATE THE PILOTING OF POTENTIAL SOLUTIONS TO STATE TECHNOLOGY REQUIREMENTS. IN OPERATING THE ICENTER, THE DIRECTOR SHALL ENSURE THAT ALL STATE LAWS, RULES, AND POLICIES ARE FOLLOWED. VENDOR PARTICIPATION IN THE ICENTER SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO:
    - (A) CREATE ANY TYPE OF PREFERRED STATUS FOR VENDORS; OR
- 12 (B) ABROGATE THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE DIRECTOR ENSURE THAT AGENCY AND 13 STATEWIDE REQUIREMENTS FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT ARE AWARDED 14 BASED ON A COMPETITIVE PROCESS THAT FOLLOWS TECHNOLOGY PROCUREMENT 15 GUIDELINES.
- 2. BEGINNING JULY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FIFTEEN, THE DIRECTOR SHALL REPORT TO THE ASSEMBLY OVERSIGHT, ANALYSIS AND INVESTIGATION COMMITTEE AND THE SENATE INVESTIGATIONS AND GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS COMMITTEE ON A QUARTERLY BASIS ON INITIATIVES BEING DEVELOPED AND IMPLEMENTED WITHIN THE ICENTER, AS WELL AS ON THE SOURCES AND AMOUNTS OF RESOURCES USED TO SUPPORT THE ICENTER.
- 22 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
