AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to permitting apportionment of state aid where a school was not in session due to extraordinary weather conditions, disasters or emergencies during the two thousand twelve-two thousand thirteen school year

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3604 of the education law is amended by adding a new subdivision 7-b to read as follows:

3 7-B. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION SEVEN OF THIS SECTION, FOR THE TWO THOUSAND TWELVE--TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN SCHOOL YEAR, 5 THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DISREGARD SUCH REDUCTION, UP TO TEN DAYS, IN THE APPORTIONMENT OF PUBLIC MONEY, IF THE SCHOOLS OF THE DISTRICT WERE NOT 7 IN SESSION FOR ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY DAYS BECAUSE OF EXTRAORDINARILY 8 ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS, FEDERAL DECLARATIONS OF NATURAL DISASTERS, A 9 DISASTER EMERGENCY AS DEFINED IN SECTION TWENTY OF THE 10 LAW, THE CLOSING OF TRANSPORTATION ROUTES PURSUANT TO A DECLARED STATE OF EMERGENCY, IMPAIRMENT OF HEATING FACILITIES, 11 INSUFFICIENCY OF WATER SUPPLY, SHORTAGE OF FUEL, LACK OF ELECTRICITY, OR THE DESTRUCTION 12 13 SCHOOL BUILDING EITHER IN WHOLE OR IN PART, AND IF, FURTHER, THE DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT CERTIFIES THAT SUCH DISTRICT CANNOT MAKE UP SUCH 14 SECONDARY 15 DAYS OF INSTRUCTION BY USING FOR THE GRADES ALLSCHEDULED VACATION DAYS WHICH OCCUR PRIOR TO THE FIRST SCHEDULED REGENTS EXAMINA-16 IN JUNE, AND FOR THE ELEMENTARY GRADES ALL SCHEDULED VACATION 17 DAY DAYS WHICH OCCUR PRIOR TO THE LAST SCHEDULED REGENTS EXAMINATION DAY 18 19 IF, FURTHER, THE DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT CERTIFIES TO THE JUNE; 20 COMMISSIONER THAT TO DO SO WOULD IMPERIL STUDENTS, FACULTY 21 WHILE REPAIRS CONTINUE. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, "SCHEDULED

22 VACATION DAYS" SHALL MEAN DAYS ON WHICH THE SCHOOLS OF THE DISTRICT ARE 23 NOT IN SESSION AND FOR WHICH NO PROHIBITION EXISTS IN SUBDIVISION EIGHT

24 OF THIS SECTION FOR THEM TO BE IN SESSION.

25 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
