AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to allowing certain disabled persons to take fish without a license

PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-THE BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 11-0707 of the environmental conservation law is 2 amended by adding a new subdivision 3-a to read as follows:

3 PERSON WHO IS DISABLED MAY TAKE FISH AS IF HE OR SHE HELD A 3-A. ANY 4 FISHING LICENSE, EXCEPT THAT HE OR SHE MAY NOT TAKE BAIT FISH BY NET OR 5 TRAP, IF HE OR SHE HAS ON HIS OR HER PERSON AN AUTHORIZATION UPON A FORM FURNISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT CONTAINING SUCH IDENTIFYING INFORMATION AND б 7 DATA AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY IT. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION MEANS HAVING A MEDICALLY DETERMINABLE IMPAIRMENT OF SUFFI-8 "DISABLED" CIENT SEVERITY AND DURATION TO QUALIFY FOR BENEFITS UNDER 9 SECTION 1902 10 (A)(10)(A)(II)(XV) OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT.

S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 11 it shall have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediate-12 ly, the commissioner of environmental conservation is authorized and directed to add, amend, and/or repeal any rule or regulation necessary 13 14 15 for the timely implementation of this act on such effective date.
