AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to allowing individuals duly licensed out-of-state to carry a pistol or firearm to carry such weapon within the state for a limited duration

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 400.15 to 2 read as follows:

3 S 400.15 RECIPROCITY WITH OTHER STATES.

1. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE 4 CONTRARY, ANY 5 PERSON DULY LICENSED TO CARRY A PISTOL OR FIREARM BY ANOTHER JURISDIC-6 TION WITHIN THE UNITED STATES SHALL BE ALLOWED TO CARRY SUCH PISTOL OR 7 YORK STATE FOR A PERIOD OF TIME NOT TO EXCEED ONE FIREARM WITHIN NEW 8 MONTH. PERSONS INTENDING TO STAY IN THE STATE IN EXCESS OF ONE MONTH OR 9 PERSONS CHANGING RESIDENCE OR DOMICILE TO NEW YORK STATE SHALL BE REOUIRED TO COMPLY WITH ALL STATE OR LOCAL LAWS 10 PERTAINING TO THE 11 LICENSING OF FIREARMS.

CARRYING A FIREARM UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION 12 2. PERSONS 13 SHALL BE REQUIRED TO: (A) CARRY THE OUT-OF-STATE PERMIT TOGETHER WITH 14 VALID IDENTIFICATION WHENEVER THE PERSON IS CARRYING THE PISTOL OR FIREARM; (B) DISCLOSE TO ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT 15 OFFICER THAT THEPERSON 16 HOLDS A VALID PERMIT AND IS CARRYING A PISTOL OR FIREARM WHEN APPROACHED 17 OR ADDRESSED BY THE OFFICER, AND SHALL DISPLAY BOTH THE PERMIT AND THE PROPER IDENTIFICATION UPON THE REQUEST OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER. 18 19 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
