AN ACT to amend the New York state urban development corporation act, in relation to the establishment of an African-American and African-Caribbean business development center

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 174 of the laws of 1968, constituting  
2     the New York state urban development corporation act, is amended by  
3     adding a new section 9-g to read as follows:  
4     S 9-G. CREATING AN AFRICAN-AMERICAN AND AFRICAN-CARIBBEAN BUSINESS  
5     DEVELOPMENT CENTER. THE CORPORATION SHALL PROVIDE, WITH THE ASSISTANCE  
6     OF THE COMMISSIONER OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND IN CONSULTATION WITH  
7     SUCH COMMISSIONER, AN AFRICAN-AMERICAN AND AFRICAN-CARIBBEAN BUSINESS  
8     DEVELOPMENT CENTER FOR THE PURPOSES OF RENDERING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE  
9     AND MARKET INFORMATION TO NOT-FOR-PROFIT SERVICE PROVIDERS AND THE  
10    PRIVATE BUSINESSES SERVICING AFRICAN-AMERICAN AND AFRICAN-CARIBBEAN  
11    COMMUNITIES.  
12    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
