- AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to exempting compensation for active military service from inclusion in a resident's adjusted gross income

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph 8 of subsection (c) of section 612 of the tax 2 law, as amended by chapter 528 of the laws of 1964, is amended to read 3 as follows:

4 (8) Compensation received for active service in the armed forces of 5 the United States [on or after October first, nineteen hundred sixtyone, and prior to September first, nineteen hundred sixty-two; provided, 6 however, that the amount of such compensation to be deducted shall not 7 8 exceed one hundred dollars for each month of the taxable year, subsequent to September, nineteen hundred sixty-one, during any part of which 9 month the taxpayer was engaged in such service] IF: (A) 10 THE TAXPAYER MAINTAINED A PERMANENT RESIDENCE IN NEW YORK STATE AND SERVED IN THE 11 ACTIVE SERVICE IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES OUTSIDE OF 12 NEW 13 YORK STATE FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST NINETY DAYS DURING THE TAXABLE YEAR; TAXPAYER MAINTAINED A PERMANENT PLACE OF ABODE OUTSIDE OF NEW 14 (B) THE 15 YORK STATE WHILE IN ACTIVE SERVICE FOR THE ENTIRE TAXABLE YEAR; OR (C) IN NEW YORK STATE OTHER THAN SUCH 16 TAXPAYER MAINTAINED AN ABODE THEPERSON'S PERMANENT ADDRESS WHILE IN ACTIVE SERVICE; INCLUDING RESIDENCE 17 IN A MILITARY BARRACKS, BACHELOR'S QUARTERS OR ON BOARD A NAVAL VESSEL. 18 19 For the purposes of this paragraph, the words "active service in the 20 armed forces of the United States" shall mean active duty (other than 21 for training) in the army, navy (including the marine corps), air force
