AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) prevention

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The correction law is amended by adding a new section 76 to 2 read as follows:
- 76. HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS (HIV) PREVENTION. UPON DISCHARGE OF AN INMATE FROM A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE INMATE WITH EDUCATIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE PREVENTION OF HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS (HIV) INFECTION, INSTRUCTIONS ABOUT HOW TO OBTAIN 7 FREE HIV TESTING UPON RELEASE, INCLUDING CONTACT INFORMATION FOR HIV TESTING SERVICE PROVIDERS LOCATED IN THE COUNTY OR CITY COUNSELING AND 9 IN WHICH SUCH INMATE INTENDS TO RESIDE UPON RELEASE, AND REFERRALS 10 COMMUNITY-BASED HIV PREVENTION, EDUCATION AND COUNSELING RESOURCES LOCATED IN THE COUNTY OR CITY IN WHICH SUCH INMATE INTENDS 11
- 12 UPON RELEASE.
- 13 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall
- 14 have become a law.
